CRITERIA FOR A SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The Red Lion Area Educational Foundation (RLAEF) manages and disperses scholarship funds to Red Lion Area Senior High School graduates. These scholarships are intended to help supplement the financial needs of graduates enrolled in education and vocational training after high school. In order to qualify for the scholarships, seniors must be admitted to and be matriculating at an accredited college or vocational school. No potential recipient will be excluded from consideration based on race, sex, or religion. A minimum GPA may be required. Financial need will be considered when evaluating candidates. In addition, applicants must demonstrate the characteristics of service, leadership, citizenship and community involvement that are worthy of recognition. The dollar amount of each award is determined by the RLAEF board, based on funds available. Scholarships are presented in the form of a check made payable to the student and the institution they are attending. The students are recognized and given the check at the annual Awards Ceremony in the Spring. Most awards are one-time grants. Acceptance of Terms of the Application if awarded a RLAEF scholarship, I agree to provide the name of the post-secondary institution which I plan to attend.
