- "Care needs to be given to the growth of young people"

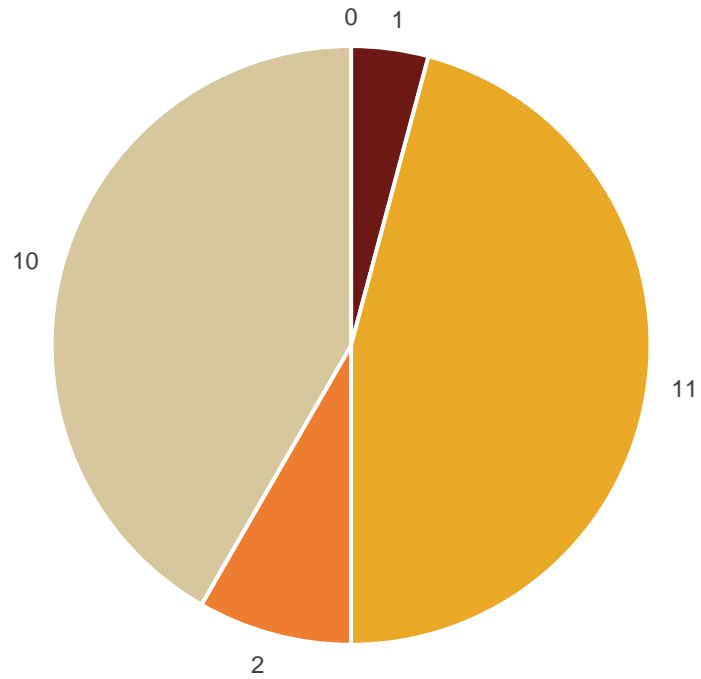
Responses Received Last Week

- "Environmental honesty"

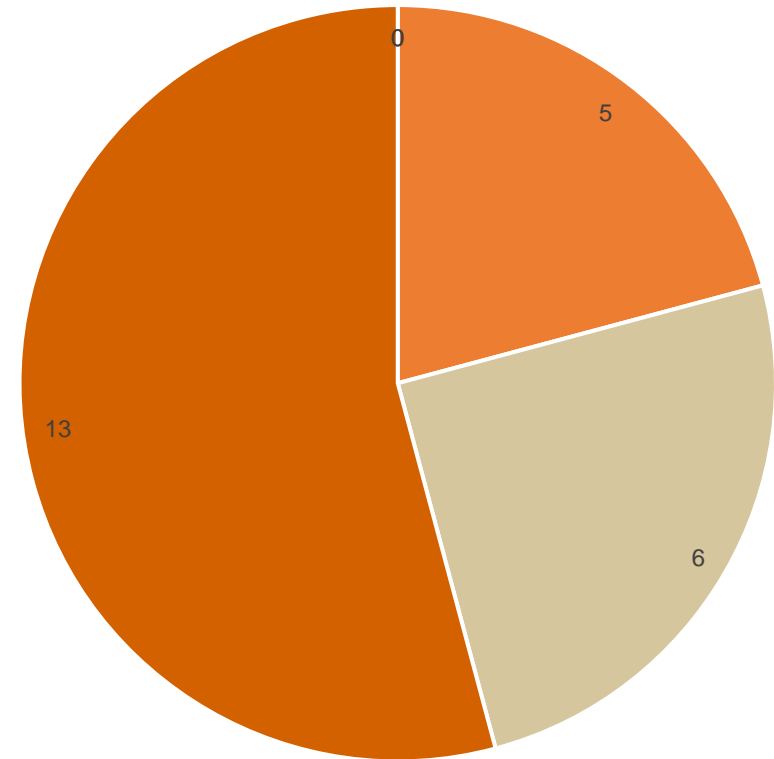

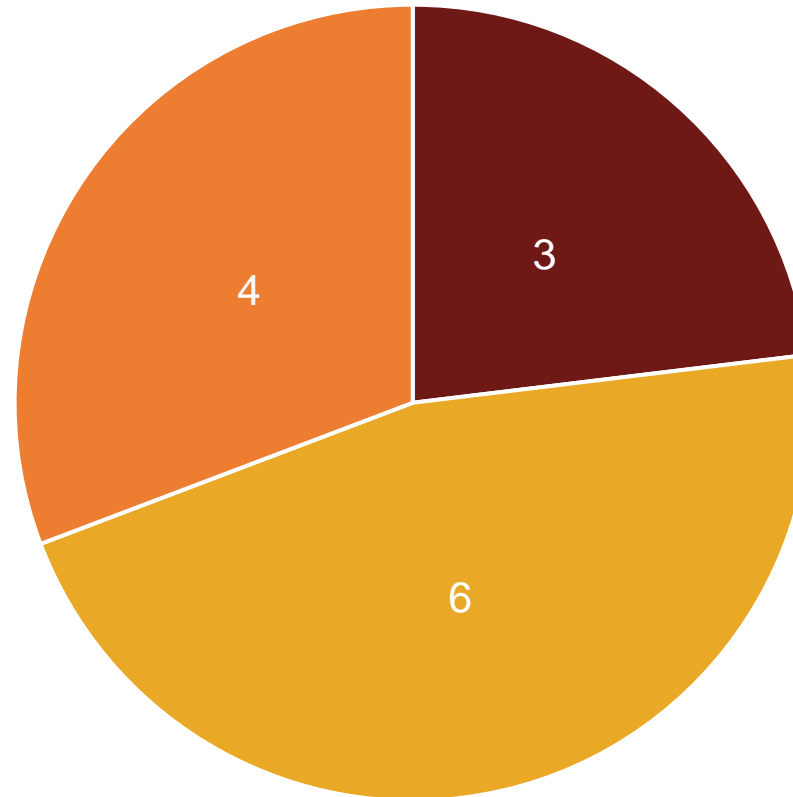
What is your age?

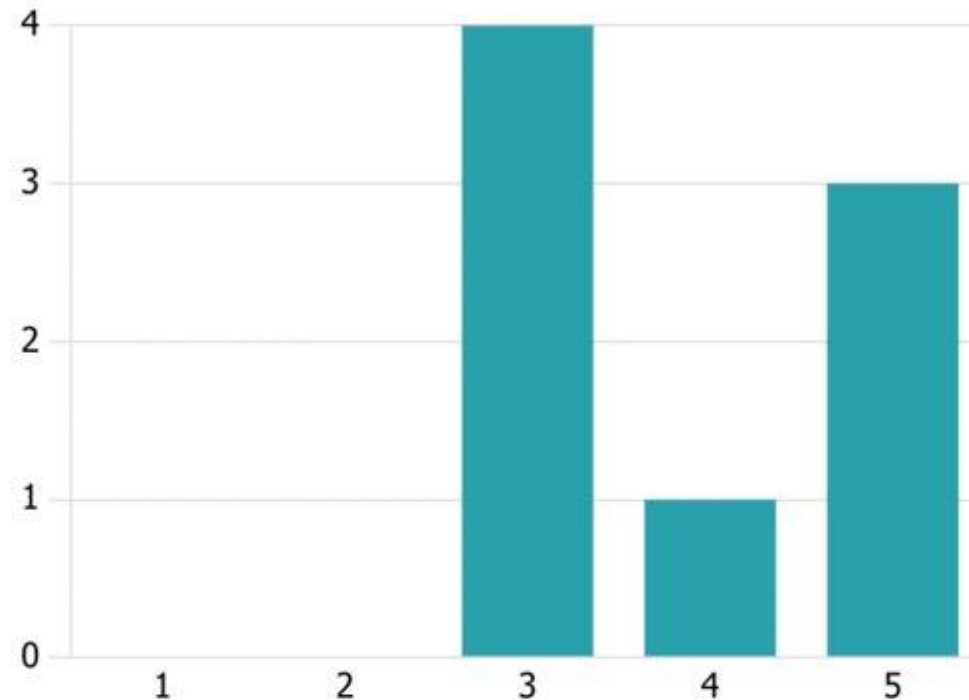
