Supervisor Lupo relayed Assessor Karns report as the assessor was not present for the meeting. Any additional residents that have come in or called with property tax queries have been assisted.

Highway Commissioner's Report:

Commissioner Rogawski provided the Town Board with the following information: Calls are coming in for pothole repair. The Commissioner is working with Tom McCabe to secure MFT funds to offset the remaining balance to DiMeo Brothers for the Bryn Mawr sewer project. Also the commissioner is working on the details with John Spina regarding our potential permit deposit requirements and subsequent fines for opening the streets in the Unincorporated area and not properly closing it.
