Learn to Perform discussion

Learn to perform (LTP) was discontinued through Salt Lake County. We don't have time to incorporate learn to perform in the Spring Show this year. Ongoing discussion moving forward. Marcela is working with a friend to send a request to county records for a list of LTP and learn to skate participants for the last 5 years so the club can market to those interested. Marcela and her friend are working on an MOU defining responsibilities and funds with the rink/county and CPFSC. We haven't gotten much back from the county yet.

We will need to work on structure; coaches, compensation, etc. Murray hasn't had success incorporating LTP with club ice time. We can follow the Aspire program for structure- Tami sent a link to the chat.

Spring Show

There will be a family number, there has been a good amount of interest. Most likely it will be the Boot Scoot Boogie.

We are planning on a matinee performance.

The show committee is working on costumes, choreography contracts for coaches and VIP pricing & benefits. There is a request for getting headsets, 3 total to be used for backstage, lighting/music. The family was upset that the club hadn't reached out to check on the parent prior to asking about interest in registering for the Spring Show. They don't feel supported by the club. We discussed reaching out to the family with an apology/expressing concern. We are reaching out to USFSA first and will follow up.
