In June, a large Hackberry Tree fell across a sidewalk on Brightwater Drive. The Grounds Committee felt we needed to have some Hackberry's along Brightwater (on the lake side) professionally assessed for possibly falling. Our Missouri City Forester spent over one hour on our grounds looking at the trees I was concerned about. He felt three of our Hackberry Trees and one Ash tree were "hollow" and could pose a danger if they fell. He recommended removal of these trees. There were also three trees in Northshore Park that should be removed. We have contracted with our tree removal company to have these trees removed very soon.

TRIM THOSE TREES!



Both Missouri City and the Brightwater Homeowners Association require that trees be kept prudently trimmed. How much? Per City ordinance, tree limbs must be at least 8 feet above the sidewalks and 14 feet above the streets. Quite a few trees are bending lower than these heights in Brightwater, especially with the rain we've had this summer. Low hanging branches over streets are catching taller trucks and emergency vehicles. Please take a few minutes, check your tree limbs and prune if they don't meet these requirements. Also trim branches that impede traffic views at street intersections or hang low near our cluster mailboxes. Thank you!

He began his law-enforcement career with the Missouri City Police Department in January 1989 as a Patrol Officer and subsequently served as Field Training Officer, Crime Scene Investigator, Patrol Sergeant, Patrol Lieutenant and Captain of the Patrol Division. He oversaw the department's respected community outreach program through which supervisors are assigned to attend homeowners' association meetings and collaborate with residents on crime prevention measures. Chief Berezin is a graduate of the Leadership Command College at Sam Houston State University in Huntsville, Texas, and of the 236th Session of the FBI National Academy in Quantico, Virginia.

Sidewalk Repair

Uneven sidewalks are a trip hazard. Missouri City sidewalk repair procedures have changed so there is no cost to the homeowner. To request a repair, email Crystal Nix, Public Works Office Manager, at cnix@missouricitytx.gov with an address nearest the sidewalk. The location will be placed on a waiting list for evaluation.

Most uneven sidewalks are caused by tree roots that must be cut prior to repair. The homeowner is expected to sign a form releasing the City of responsibility if the tree dies. A barrier is placed between the root and sidewalk. Be prepared for a waiting period between making your request and the sidewalk repair.
