Pan Mee by Kevin Liew Serving for 2

Ingredients:

- 160 g, Flat Rice Noodles
- 160g, Lean Ground Pork
- ¼ White Onion (sliced)
- 1 cup, Cremini Mushrooms (sliced)
- 2 large eggs (soft boiled)
- 1 green onion/scallion
- ¼ cup, parsley
- ¼ cup, season roasted peanuts (crushed)
- 2 tbsp. shredded coconut
- 2 tbsp. pork floss
- ½ lemon (zest & juiced)
- Salt & Pepper to taste

Directions:

- Boil noodles till desired tenderness but not overcooked. Drain well and place aside.
- Pan-fry the ground pork in medium size skillet till cooked. 2. Sprinkle salt & pepper. Place aside on dish.
- Pan-frv mushrooms in medium size skillet till desired ten-3. derness. Sprinkle salt & pepper. Place aside.
- Cook onions in medium size skillet till onion turns golden 4. brown. Sprinkle salt & pepper. Place aside.
- Prepare the soft-boiled eggs by putting the eggs in boiling 5. water for 5 minutes. Then cool the eggs down in cold water to prevent further cooking.
- Assemble two plates with noodles on bottom, followed 6. by the fried pork, mushrooms and onions on the sides
- Add shelled egg to each plate in the middle. 7.
- 8. Add - Optional Toppings:
 - o Green Onion & Parsley Chop lightly.
 - o Peanuts Crush in mortar & pestle, but not com-
 - Lemon Zest lemon and place in small bowl. Squeeze lemon juice lemon into a small bowl.
 - o Coconut & Pork Floss Found at most Asian grocery stores.
