Day 1:Rome

Depart from your homeland and arrive in Rome. After the Emigration proceed to Hotel check in and Dinner and Overnight at Rome.

Day 2: Papal Audience – Rome City Tour

Today breakfast at Hotel or Packed Breakfast and check out and proceed to the St Peter Square for Papal Audience After that We will proceed to visit Holy steps (Scala Santa) John the Lateran Cathedral, visit the basilica of Holy Cross in Jerusalem. we will start our guided tour of visiting all the Major Churches in Rome, outside View of Colosseum. St. Paul's Church where we will stop for a visit After tour you will have Dinner and Overnight at Rome.

Day 3: Vatican Museum – St. Peters Basilica -Assisi – Pisa

.After Breakfast proceed to the Vatican, we will visit the Vatican Museums and a large part of the Vatican City, one of the European microstates situated on the Vatican Hill. Leaving the Piazza San Bernardo, adorned by Moses' Fountain we will visit the Vatican Museums and the Vatican Galleries (lines possible at the entrance). There you will admire the modern entrance built for the Jubilee 2000, the Galleries of the Chandeliers, of the Tapestries and of the Geographical Maps, the Sobiesky Hall and the Immaculate Conception Hall. We will then stop to admire the Sistine Chapel, seat of the Conclave, with the famous frescoes of Michelangelo. Passing inside the Vatican Museums we will arrive into the Basilica of Saint Peter, commonly called Saint Peter's Basilica, is one of four major basilicas of Rome. It is the most prominent building inside the Vatican City and built on the ruins of Old Saint Peter's Basilica. After that proceed to Assisi. You will have a Guided Tour of Assisi, where our sightseeing includes visits to the Church of St. Clare which houses her incorrupt body. One of the chapels contains the crucifix that bowed its head and ordered St. Francis to "repair God's Church." Afterwards, we proceed to the Basilica of St. Francis, built in 1228 to house the Relics of the saint. The "upper" basilica houses beautiful frescoes of Giotto. Before leaving Assisi, we visit the Church of Santa Maria DegliAngeli, containing the famous Porziuncola. This very ancient chapel, venerated for an apparition of angels within it, was originally property of the Benedictines of Subasio. It was located on a piece of land known as the Portiuncula; this name became attached to the chapel. After a long period of abandonment, it was restored by St. Francis. Here, he was given a dear understanding of his vocation. He founded here the Order of Friars Minor (1209), "establishing here his home. Proceed to Pisa. On arrival to Pisa check in to the Hotel Dinner at Hotel and overnight at Pisa.

Day 4:Pisa – Venice – Padua

After breakfast check out and proceed to visit view the Leaning Tower of Pisa. Then to Venice after lunch you will be transferred to Venice (Approx. 45 mins) where you will board a ferry and Transfer to Venice Islands. Tour will start at St Mark's Square. Walking tour of the area between Piazza San Marco and the Rialto Bridge, passing through la Fenice Theatre, Scala del Bovolo, Ponte di Rialto & St. Mark's square and then we proceed to Hotel. Then proceed to Padua check in to the Hotel Dinner at Hotel and overnight stay in Padua.

Day 5: Venice – Milan – Engelberg

After breakfast check out proceed to visit Shrine of St Anthony of Padua on your own and also celebrate Mass (to be confirmed on arrival). then proceed to Milan have lunch then Visit Dumo Cathedral. The biggest and greatest example of Gothic architecture in Italy, it is the fourth largest cathedral in the world .Built between 1386 and 1577, it hosts the world's largest collection of marble statues. then then proceed to Engel berg. Dinner at Hotel and overnight at Engelberg.

Day 6: Engelberg – Heppenheim

After Breakfast ,Check out We will proceed to Mt Titlis, the TITLIS ROTAIR gondola rotates its way up towards the snow-covered summit of TITLIS. The world's first revolving gondola transports you from the middle station at Stand up to the mountain station at 3,020 meters above sea-level. With Indian Lunch. After Lunch proceed to Heppenheim. On the way will visit The Rhine Falls at Schaffhausen Dinner and Overnight at Heppenheim.

Day 7: Heppenheim – Cologne – Amsterdam

After breakfast, you will transfer to Cologne You will visit Cologne with Oasis Tour Manager, you can see Cologne Cathedral. After Tour you will have Indian Lunch at Cologne and after lunch you will drive to Amsterdam (Approx. 3 hrs. 30 mins) Dinner and Overnight at Amsterdam.

Day 8: Amsterdam – Madurodam – Brussels

After breakfast, you will proceed to visit Amsterdam with guide and you will see The Dam, Albert Cuyp market, Amsterdam windmills, Amsterdam's canals. After that you will see Madurodam which is a miniature park with entrance. After Lunch. Proceed to Brussels Dinner and Overnight at Brussels.

Day 9: Brussels – Paris

After breakfast, proceed for a City Tour of Brussels where you will see Cathedral of St. Michael and St. Gondola, Brussels Town Hall and Place Royale. After lunch proceed to Paris You will transfer to Paris (Approx. 4 hrs. 30 mins) Upon arrival to Paris, Then Dinner at Local Restaurant and Overnight at Paris.

Day 10: Paris

After breakfast proceed for full day City tour of Paris drive past Champs Elysees, Arc de Triomphe, the Opera, Petit Palais and Grand Palais, Les Invalides and 3 Churches Notre Dame Cathedral, Miraculas Medal & St. Vincent Paul. Then Proceed to Seine Cruise and Visit Eiffel Tower 2nd level (Subject to availability) after Dinner at Local Restaurant and Overnight at Paris.

Day 11: Paris – Lourdes

After Breakfast, We Proceed for a long drive to Lourdes (Approx. 10hrs) Lunch will be packed or en route. Upon arrival at Lourdes, Check into Hotel. You can go for the Candlelight Procession around 9pm. Dinner and Overnight at Lourdes.
