

COMMUNITY SERVICE QUILT KIT

Approximate size: 47" x 60"

	<u>Fabric included in kit</u>	<u>Instructions for Quilter</u>	
Quilt Center:	(13) 10" squares	Leave whole	
	(3) 10" squares	Cut into (12) 5" squares	See Note 1
	(9) 3" wide strips	Cut (24) 5" lengths	See Note 2
		Cut (24) 10" lengths	See Note 2, 3
Borders:	(3) 2½" wide strips	Join strips and cut into (2) 47" lengths	
	(6) 10" squares	Cut into (24) 5" squares	See Note 5
Backing/binding:	4½ Yards		
Batting	50" x 65"		

Note 1: Cut each 10" square in half vertically and horizontally to make a total of (12) 5" squares. Select random squares of your choice.

Note 2: Sew the 5" strips to the top and bottom of the 5" square. Press outward toward strips. Sew the 10" strips to the remaining sides and press. Pieced block should measure 10"x10". Repeat until you have completed 12 blocks.

Note 3: Alternate sewing a 10" layer cake square (LC) to a pieced block (PB) to form rows.
 Row 1: LC, PB, LC, PB, LC
 Row 2: PB, LC, PB, LC, PB

Continue to form 5 rows of 5 blocks each. Sew the rows together and press seams.

Note 4: Sew the 47:" strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center to form sashings.

Note 5: Cut each 10" square in half vertically and horizontally to make a total of (24) 5" squares. Select random squares of your choice.

Join together (11) 5" squares for each row of border. Sew each border to top and bottom sashings. Press seams.
