Advocacy Our Independent Sexual Violence Advocates (ISVAs) and Children Independent Sexual Violence Advocates (CHISVAs) work alongside survivors and provide support and advocacy navigating the criminal justice system.

Counselling Professional, specialised sexual violence counselling provided to survivors of sexual violence, their family members and carers.

Under 11's Therapy Specialist therapy through play for children of school age in our specially designed playroom.

Group Workshops Groups for young people and adults. Adult groups have Wellbeing Groups, which include a guided meditation class. Girls to the Front (GTFF) is a group for young people which run weekly; past sessions included Boba Tea Workshop, a trip to the theatre and activism classes.
