A Message from Pastor Jaime

This year, we are starting Lent a day early, so mark your calendar for "Ash Tuesday" worship on Tuesday, February 13.

Because of scheduling complications, Heidi, our musician, and I can't be here at the same time on Ash Wednesday, February 14. But Tuesday the 13th is also our Senior Dinner, which is already followed by a worship service each month. Because we already have a service scheduled – and Heidi is able to join us – we decided to make that night's service an "Ash Tuesday" service.

You might remember that last year, we canceled our Ash Wednesday service because of bad weather, and our imposition of ashes happened on Sunday morning. So changing the day isn't something entirely new. The important thing is that we have this opportunity to begin the season of Lent with intention.

We receive ashes on our foreheads as a sign of our need to repent, to confess our sins, and turn back to God.

Lent is a season of reflection and spiritual discipline (or practice). During this season, you might give up something that draws you away from God, or you might take up a practice that brings you closer.

For some people, midweek worship is one of those practices. While we won't be having midweek services at Bethel until Holy Week, you are invited to join Gloria Dei for midweek worship. Services will begin at 11:15 am Wednesdays during Lent and will be followed by a light lunch. Recordings of the services will also be available on Bethel's website and Facebook page if you'd like to join online.

The theme for those services is "Altered by the Spirit." We will be invited into the spiritual practice of paying attention to the Holy Spirit at work among us by reflecting on how the Spirit is at work in the book of Acts. As we explore these stories, we'll see how God works through the spirit to transform us – to alter

Holy Week worship will take place here at Bethel. We'll worship at 5 pm on Maundy Thursday, March 28, and again at 5 pm on Good Friday, March 29. And we will gather to celebrate the Resurrection at 8:30 am on Easter Sunday, March 31.
