## A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR KELLI

Ash Wednesday is coming up next Wednesday. It's on Valentine's Day. That's kind of a strange juxtaposition, don't you think? Valentine's Day is all of the mushy and celebrating kind of love. We give each other cards, candy, and we might even go on a date. Ash Wednesday is kind of the opposite. It's a bit somber and quiet. It's a day when we put ashes on our foreheads and remind each other that "we are dust, and to dust we shall return," essentially a reminder of our fragility and brokenness, and that none of us are so powerful that we can't die. I know it's not quite as obvious as Valentine's Day, but Ash Wednesday is also about love.

It's about love because it's honest. It's a day when we don't pretend all is good and happy in life, it's a day when we don't pretend that we are invincible, it's a day when we don't pretend to be perfect or sinless. It's a day when we are honest with our brokenness and our humanness. And, it's about love because in all of that mess that we are honest about, we're met with a promise of new life, a new life that will conquer death. We're met with a promise of forgiveness and hope. We're met with a promise of God's love for us, that is for us, even when we're honest about everything that leaves us feeling lonely and unlovable.

Next week I invite you to join us on Ash Wednesday at 7:00 pm and remember God's love for you, a love that is stronger than even death.


