THE BASICS OF YOUR ROLE

Here are the 1-2-3s of being an Employee Campaign Leader (ECL)

What is an Employee Campaign Leader (ECL)?

An ECL is a company employee and United Way of White County volunteer leader who oversees a portion of their company's United Way Campaign. You are the key to campaign success. Being an ECL allows your company to shine.

What do I do?

Very simply; you ask individuals to consider making a payroll deduction for organizations that align with their philanthropic interests. An employee who chooses to participate can designate their pledge to a non-profit in White County, or support United Way of White County Programming in general where their pledges go to the community's greatest needs.

- Remind them that many hands make light work! If everyone gives even the smallest portion, the impact will be great! United Way is designed to turn small dollars in to large investments that make a difference.
- Use the campaign emails templates, videos, and posters. Send reminders.
- Remember giving is a personal decision. We are thankful for their consideration, whether they give or not.

ECL CHECKLIST

Plan

- Schedule an appointment with your United Way
- Go to unitedwayofwhitecounty.org/toolkit for your sample materials
- Secure Support from your CEO/HR manager
- Establish a goal, and share progress
- Help schedule a time to visit for the United Way Executive Director

Gear Up

- Establish a timeline
- Begin campaign promotion iwht posters and advance emails to staff.
 Resources can be found at unitwayofwhitecounty.org/toolkit.
- If possible, update your website to include your commitment to social responsibility (UWWC Logos are found at unitedwayofwhitecounty.org/toolkit).

Run (Kickoff)

- Hand out/email pledge forms to employees
- Send follow-up emails every few days to keep up enthusiasm
- Hold a fundraising event or incentive (see ideas)
- Give employees the opportunity to learn more about United way by coordinating speakers, or arranging volunteer activities

Close

- Send a reminder email that your campaign is concluding and encourage participation
- Collect pledge forms
- Contact your United way for envelope pick up
- Submit contribution forms and final report date to your payroll department
- Announce Campaign Results!
- Thank employees with a celebration event, letter, email, etc.
- Choose next year's ELC, give any notes, and provide this information to United Way of White County

FUN CAMPAIGN IDEAS

Host a kickoff breakfast for your company like donut day, and have them pick up their pledge forms during this time. Consider having a United Way of White County representative to speak.

Enter participating employees in a raffle for a day off.

Make sure to share milestones throughout the year. This encourages employees to give and help meet the goal. For example, "Jeans Day" at halfway through the goal, etc.

Contact us to organize a volunteer opportunity for employees to gain perspective on how their gift will be put to work.

Do a parking space raffle quarterly for those who donate.

If you're the boss, offer to trade jobs for a 1/2 day! Enter donors into a drawing.
