She later competed in the next level of competition, called the MidAmerica Regional Contest, on July 21, 2022, at St. Louis University. The winner of this contest won a scholarship for \$5000.

Each Regional Winner went on to compete in the World Championship Contest for a chance to win a first, second, or third place scholarship of \$15,000, \$10,000, or \$5,000 respectively.

TCA Optimist Club is very proud of Olivia for her accomplishments. She was an 8th grader from Senn Thomas Middle School when she competed in our club and district contests. She competed with high school graduates in the regional contest.

game and shoe rental from Quonset Lanes. All the kids received treat bags. We thank Quonset Lanes for partnering with us to offer this fun event to the community.










Dictionary Program

"Educators describe third grade as the time when a student transitions from learning to read to reading to learn."








We support the local Head Start Program in multiple ways. Twice a year before Easter and Thanksgiving the Head Start staff selects five deserving families to receive food, personal hygiene and household supplies. Members are encouraged to donate five like items for each of the collection periods. The club's budget also provides funds to purchase additional items and fresh food. Members complete the shopping and Head Start staff delivers several months of provisions to the families.

We also host annual Christmas parties for the two Head Start facilities in Hematite and De Soto. Children receive hats, gloves, sweatshirts/pants, books, and more. They also get a visit from Santa with a gift for each child. Most of the children have also received coats from our Coats for Kids Program.

Recently TCA Optimists have donated money to cover supply costs for an Eagle Scout project to build 16 Head Start Lending Libraires for Jefferson and Franklin Counties. The club also donated close to 1000 used books to fill the library boxes. Karter Reese is the boy scout working on this project to earn his Eagle Scout rank.







Coats for Kids Program

The club's Coats for Kids Program has been ongoing for around 30 years. TCA Optimists work with area school counselors to provide coats for those in need. Recent years has seen a marked increase in requests. We are fortunate to receive a \$5,500 grant from Jefferson Foundation. That along with

annual fundraisers, sponsorships, and donations help us to keep up with demand. Recently schools are also requesting hats and gloves. Since the start of the school year, we already distributed close to 500 coats and orders keep coming in.

Our club assembled learning boxes for Parents as Teachers affiliate. Forty boxes, along with additional pre-school supplies were donated. These learning materials help to improve cognitive and gross/fine motor skills. We were fortunate to receive a matching \$300 Childhood Health and Wellness Grant from Optimist International Foundation.









Annual Art Contest

TCA Optimist Club held its annual Art Contest on **Sunday November** 6th at the Elks Lodge in Festus. 182 students from 11 southern **Jefferson County** schools entered over 250 pieces of art for judging. Here are some of the volunteers who helped make this year's contest successful.




Bunco
