The Mastodon Art/Science Regional Fair is open to all students in grades K-12. Projects can be individual or group projects in the fields of art or science. Students can be enrolled in public, private, or be homeschooled. Teachers, parents, or guardians can enter one project from each division. The cost per project is \$10 until registration cut-off on February 28, at that time the registration fee goes up to \$20 per project. It is scheduled for March 20-26.

Students in middle and high school who wish to qualify and move on to the national level, must be from the following counties: Brown, IL; Callaway, MO; Crawford, MO; Dent, MO;

Franklin, MO; Gasconade, MO; Jackson, IL; Jefferson, MO; Maries, MO; Osage, MO; Perry, IL; Phelps, MO; Randolph, IL; Union, IL; St. Francois, MO (Art Only); Ste. Genevieve, MO (Art Only); St. Louis, MO (Art Only), and Washington, MO.

The 2020 Seniors Only Fair awarded \$3,200 worth of prizes. The 2021 Fair awarded \$6,200 worth of prizes.


