



Honorable mention went to Elizabeth Check as Old Waiter, Queen Karen Huskey, and Blood Donor Kim Smith.






















Members meet at Taytro's every Thursday at Noon - 1 p.m. The last Thursday of the month is an evening meeting. Time and place TBD.
