### Fever Screening Guidelines: No more under-the-tongue temp checks

**Updated Guidelines:** As more shopping centers and restaurants begin to reopen, checking for fevers will become common for both employees and the general public. **It is recommended that you check your temperature before leaving home.**

#### The 2 Most Common Signs of illness:

Having a fever of at least 100.4 and losing your sense of taste/smell.

Experts say the accuracy of temperature checking depends on the type of thermometer being used. Non-

contact approach can reduce the risk of spreading disease between people being evaluated.
