The Extension meeting of the Prospect Borough Council was called to order by V. President Robert Boice with a Salute to the Flag. The following Council Members were present Robert Boice, Dave Stellfox, Gus Guenther, Ed Robinson, Glen Gitzen and Mayor Butler.

Michael English was present to answer questions on whether or not it is legal to hold the extension Council Meetings. He replied that the Borough is doing it correctly. Michael English stated that the borough needs an updated Ordinance on Flood Plan Management and to be Ok'd by FEMA for residents to be eligible for Flood Plan Insurance. A new Ordinance to replace the old one needs to be updated. Motion was made by Ed Robinson and seconded by Dave Stellfox to have Michael English to go on with the Ordinance and submit it to the DEP by May 16th and all present voted yes. The Storm Water Management Ordinance is to be voted on at the June Council Meeting. Michael English will get in touch with Bell Deemer for any questions.
