The regular meeting of the Prospect Borough Council was called to order by President Vaccarello with a salute to the Flag. The following Council Members were present, Nick Vaccarello, Doug Trimble, Gus Guenther, Glen Dalton, Jim Harmon. Teddy Davis, Bob Boice and Mayor Butler were absent,

Motion was made by Gus Guenther and seconded by Glen Dalton to approve the minutes from the last meeting and all present unanimously voted yes.

Visitors: Roni Hall was present to check with Council to see if May 24^{th,} 2008 was satisfactory for the Memorial Day Parade. The Parade line up will start at 9:15am and the parade will start at 10:00am. Council agreed to the date and time and Roni was informed about the insurance requirements.

Police Reports: The Police report was presented by Chief Tatton, he worked 32 1/2 hours and Ed Pfeil worked 29 1/2 hours with 165 miles patrolled.

Parks: Bob Boice was absent but called to inform Council that everything is good with the Grant money per Gary Pinkerton.

Streets: Gus Guenther is to meet with Rich Knapko from Penn Dot on Wednesday to review and inspect the Borough streets for future repairs. George Wagner is to handle the water and gravel problem on Kennedy Road in the spring. The 35 mile per hour signs on South 528 have been repaired. It was discussed about getting a 3 point sweeper to clean up the tar and chips from the winter plowing. The open ditch on Wilson Road will be repaired with a small catch basin or something similar.

Sewage: Doug reviewed the January sewage meeting and Rob Hixson got his log books back. Jeremy Olsen reviewed a letter to Borough Council about TV vs Pressure testing when a home is being sold in the Borough. Mike English said the Borough should choose one or the other testing procedures, Jeremy Olsen to draft a letter explaining what procedure the Borough will use depending on the situation and not limited to one. Motion was made by Doug Trimble and seconded by Glen Dalton to have Jeremy Olsen write a letter on how the Borough will handle each situation. Mike English will prepare a resolution. Estimate of the costs will be prepared by Jeremy Olsen for this project. Rob Hixson and Shawn McElroy will e-mail all downloaded meter information to Jeremy Olsen now that we have the software here.
