# **DEAR PARENTS:**

Welcome back from Spring Break, I hope that all of you had a fun and well rested week. The teachers and I had a restful week, and we are very excited to hear the stories the children will be sharing with us about what they did during their time off.

The month of April will be all about **basic concepts** and **metamorphosis** - the life cycles of the frogs and butterflies!

I'm For Kids Team Pre-assessments: As some of you may be aware, Preschool 101 is partnered up with I'm For Kids Team; a non-profit organization. This year we will again be holding pre-assessments for students who are currently in our 3-year old program and are returning to our 4-year old program. To qualify, your child must already be registered for our fall program. Our pre-assessments this year will be conducted on Sat, May 11<sup>th</sup> at the Preschool; an appointment is required to attend. There is no charge for the use of this service as it is funded by the Government of Alberta. If your child meets the requirements for this service, they will be provided with this benefit during class time in the upcoming school year. This program is designed to support the development of your child and to get them ready for kindergarten. As most children, currently at the toddler/preschool age, have been impacted during the pandemic, this assessment will be able to help you to see if your child may have any developmental delays (ie social & emotional, fine & gross motor, speech & language). This is highly recommended so that we can plan and provide the best programming for your child. Contact us for more information.

Dates to Remember:

April 8<sup>th</sup> – First day back after Spring Break

Illness Protocol: Children 18 and under with only one of the non-core symptoms should still stay home and monitor for 24 hours, but if they improve, they can return to normal activities. If they have two or more symptoms, however, they should stay home until the symptoms improve. Also remember to contact us by email or call us to leave a voicemail to let us know; don't forget to mention your child's name and their class time.

#### **DISCIPLINE POLICY:**

At *Preschool 101*, we recognize that children are always learning and growing to develop as an individual with distinct character at different ages. It is our responsibility as Teachers and Parents to establish guidelines to foster good behaviour by communicating with the children so they can learn to respect themselves, their peers, the authorities and environment around them.

At *Preschool 101* we teach, create, promote and model positive behaviour for our preschoolers. However, should any behavioural expectations need to be addressed; the following techniques will be used:

- Redirection to a choice of another activity (if applicable);
- Recognizing and rewarding positive behaviour;
- Discussion with child if they show inappropriate or disrespectful behaviour;
- Temporary removal from the group, inside the classroom, for some "thinking time" (1 minute per age of child);
- Teacher and Parent will meet to discuss strategy for further steps to be taken if the child continues to misbehave in class. If required, the Principal Educator may be requested to take part in the meeting.

The following practices are **PROHIBITED** at *Preschool 101*:

- Children will not be disciplined in a punitive manner;
- Physical punishment;
- Withholding food;
- · Emotional deprivation; and
- Isolation.

#### FIELD TRIPS:

Periodically, *Preschool 101* will take field trips in the City of Calgary and vicinity thereof, when, in the opinion of the Principal Educator, defines them of educational value and as an essential part of the school program. It is agreed that these educational field trips may take place anytime during the school term. Before each field trip, a special notice will be provided to the Parents/Guardians with information naming the area to be visited; including date/time of the field trip. This notice and waiver will require a Parent or Guardian's signature in order to grant permission for the student to participate.
