- We aim to foster a love of the land through promoting ethical hunting and outdoor activities.

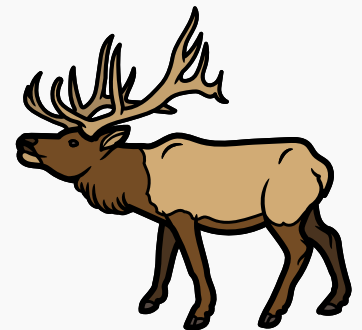
