Dogs which require measuring:

Dogs in the Proficient Category, Novice, Open or Elite jumping 4", 8", 12" or 16"

Dogs which do not need to be measured:

Dogs jumping 16" in the Veteran or Junior Handler Division Dogs jumping 20" Dogs in the Skilled Category Dogs with a permanent height card Dogs listed on the Height Exemption List

JUMP HEIGHTS

There are four Standard Division-Proficient jump heights: 8", 12", 16", and 20".

There are four Standard Division-Skilled jump heights: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

Brief Summary of Rules:

Please refer to www.nadac.com for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. https://www.nadac.com/register-your-dog/
- A copy of the current Exhibitors Handbook may be downloaded free from the NADAC web site: www.nadac.com
- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may
 cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility
 obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- No food, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within 10 feet of the ring. Food or a small non-audible toy can be in a secure container (zip-lock bag is acceptable) in your pocket during your run but you cannot indicate to the dog it is there. All handlers may bring a non-audible toy into the ring for training purposes. They cannot earn a Qualifying score and must declare to the judge they are training before they commence their run. Please read the Exhibitor's Handbook for more information about toys and training in the ring.
- The sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

AGREEMENT

- 1.1. As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, LLC., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- 1.2. Exhibitor/owner agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that. the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- 1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the surface, restrooms, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people: exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

From Helena or west:

Take ramp onto I-15 N toward US-287 N/Great Falls. Go for 5.8 mi.

Take exit 200 toward MT-279/MT-453/Lincoln Rd. Go for 0.2 mi.

Take the 3rd exit from roundabout onto Lincoln Rd E (MT-453). Go for 0.5 mi.

Take the 1st exit from roundabout onto N Montana Ave (MT-229 N). Go for 2.0 mi.

Turn left onto Prairie Rd. Go for 0.7 mi.

Turn right onto Hillview Dr. Go for 0.2 mi.

Turn Left into the second Driveway (see Hillview Sign)

From Bozeman, Townsend, Winston, or east:

Continue west on Highway 12. As you pass through East Helena,

Take ramp onto I-15 N toward US-287 N/Great Falls. Go for 7.8 mi.

Take exit 200 toward MT-279/MT-453/Lincoln Rd. Go for 0.2 mi.

Take the 3rd exit from roundabout onto Lincoln Rd E (MT-453). Go for 0.5 mi.

Take the 1st exit from roundabout onto N Montana Ave (MT-229 N). Go for 2.0 mi.

Turn left onto Prairie Rd. Go for 0.7 mi.

Turn right onto Hillview Dr. Go for 0.2 mi.

From Great Falls or north:

Take I-15 S toward Helena.

Take exit 200 toward Lincoln Rd/MT-279/MT-453. Go for 0.2 mi.
