

Replacing Lights

You will have to use a box cutter to **carefully** cut the carpet near the wiring. Gently pull the carpet lose to expose the wiring.

The side markers are attached with the double-sided sticky tape (extras included) and a dab of silicon. It is best to tape the lights in place, wire them to ensure it all works, then permanently attach them. We use contact cement glue to tack the carpet back in place.

The taillights access is under the bed extension, similar thing...carefully cut the carpet, expose the wires, fill the old holes, position new lights, wire lights (ensure left side light is installed on driver side -the license plate white light), test...then install permanently with the provided screws, washers & nuts.

Please note when removing the old Bargman lights you will need to silicon the old holes (let set) and then position the LED lights etc. If you chose, once the taillights are secured in place, you can leave the wires under the bed extension exposed as they won't really be seen-just use electrical tape to cover them, reglue the carpet in place.
