

Position Description: Distribution System Technician 2

Grade 3

General Description

TW Summit Corporation (TWS) is a water distribution system maintenance contractor. TWS assists water utilities and districts in the maintenance and operation of their water distribution system (see the list of tasks and functions below).

Working as a Crew Lead, performs operations and maintenance functions on potable water distribution systems. This position will also train subordinate personnel in the efficient and effective execution of all functions listed below.

Performs the following tasks and functions:

- Water main valve inspection & exercising
- Fire hydrant inspection & maintenance
- Water storage tank cleaning and disinfection
- Water distribution system flushing to maintain (or improve) water quality.
- Additional duties as assigned.

Equipment used ranges from simple hand tools to hydraulic valve operators to data gathering using Asset Management software that is compatible with Geographic Information Systems on notebooks and/or iPads, mobile phones, and laptop computers.

- Ability to perform Crew Lead Responsibilities.
- Ability to direct the workflow of a team.
- Ability to objectively evaluate subordinate employee(s) work performance.
- Ability to understand and follow directions from a Sr. Tech or Field Operations Supervisor.
- Ability to understand conventional underground piping systems and appurtenances.
- Ability to understand AWWA G200 and other industry standards to perform the tasks above.
- Ability to properly use hand tools of all types.
- Ability to use hydraulic tools and electric power tools.
- Ability to develop and maintain client relations.
- Must be able to follow and implement safe practices including traffic safety and confined space safety.
- Ability to communicate effectively both verbally and in writing.

Valid Colorado driver's license. Must maintain a good driving record.

Colorado Water Distribution System Operator Certification preferred.

Physical Demands

- Sit, stand, walk, kneel, crouch, stoop, squat crawl, twist, climb, push, pull, lift 50 pounds, lift 25 pounds repetitively, distinguish color, and wear protective apparel.
- Exposure to cold, heat, noise, outdoors, vibration, confining workspace, mechanical hazards, and traffic hazards.
