

SSLA Llama Ambassador Award

An **SSLA LLAMA AMBASSADOR** is: Any llama (or alpaca) that takes an active part in any public appearance to help promote and educate the public on the versatility of our llamas at such places as but not limit to: schools, libraries, parades, parks, trails, healthcare facilities, llama shows, open farm days, and community events.

COUNTING POINTS 3 WAYS:

1. A point earned for any public appearance is considered valid when you take a llama to a specific designation and the llama interacts with the public for a minimum of 30 minutes. This counts as one (1) point. If you take your llama to three (3) different designations and the llama interacts with the public at each stop, your llama can earn three (3) points. Maximum points earned for one day is five (5) points.
2. A point earned for a llama show is considered valid when the llama is used out in the walkways to interact with the public (not just in the stall or washing area). This counts as one (1) point for each day you did public interaction at the show, not one point for each interaction. Maximum points for any show is three (3) points.
3. A point earned for special open farm days, fiber workshops, or llama related educational activities on your farm is considered valid for only the llamas that are used for hands-on demonstration / interaction. This counts as one (1) point for each llama used for the day. (This does not include Youth club meetings and their routine activities hosted on your farm.)

Every llama you use for an appearance can receive Llama Ambassador points. If you take 5 llamas to a parade, each llama can receive one (1) point.

Once your llama wins an Award (for example Bronze Award) they will keep that Award status for their lifetime. The only time that their status will change is when they move up to a higher award level. The Awards will be presented each year at the SSLA Conference.

The Llama Ambassador Awards are as follows:

RECOGNITION OF MERIT CERTIFICATE:	25 Points
BRONZE LLAMA AMBASSADOR AWARD:	75 Points
SILVER LLAMA AMBASSADOR AWARD:	150 Points
GOLD LLAMA AMBASSADOR AWARD:	300 Points
ELITE LLAMA AMBASSADOR AWARD :	500 Points

MAKING EVERY POINT COUNT:

- To participate in this program, the owners must be current members of SSLA.
- Appearances / interactions between January 1 to December 31, must be submitted by January 15, of the following year to be acknowledge at the SSLA Annual Conference.
