

Here at NCS, our students are just as capable as any students across the US.

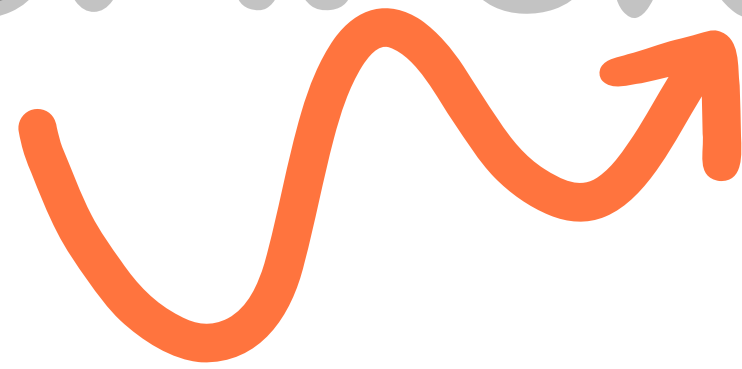
Every day, we are committed to ensuring that our students have the opportunity to grow and thrive so they can reach their potential.

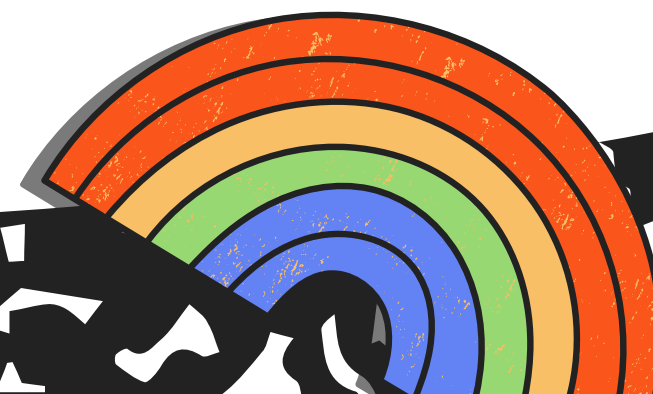

- A Professional Development Plan to ensure teachers are preparing for units and building content knowledge






OUR COMMITMENT

Our goal is to keep you informed, today and throughout the year, on the implementation of our school improvement plan.

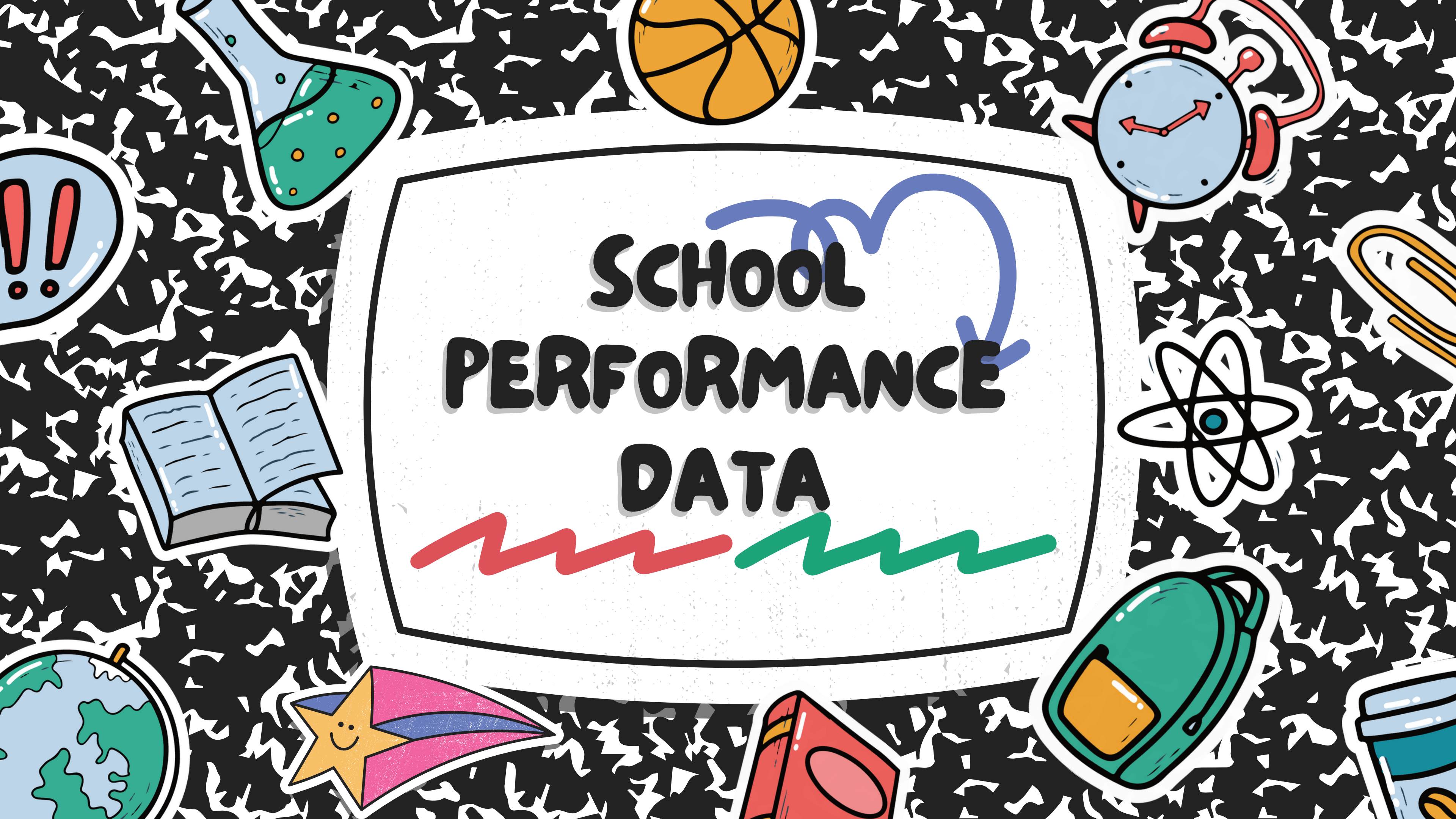

OUR GOALS

Given the data we've shared, Northshore Charter School is focused on the following priorities for the 2023-2024 school year:

- The assessment index for the 2023-2024 school year will rise to a minimum of 55.0.
- On the LEAP2025 Assessment for 2023-2024, 35% of ELA students will score at a level of “Mastery” or “Advanced.”
- On the LEAP2025 Assessment for 2023-2024, 25% of math students will score “Mastery” or “Advanced.”




LET'S WORK TOGETHER
