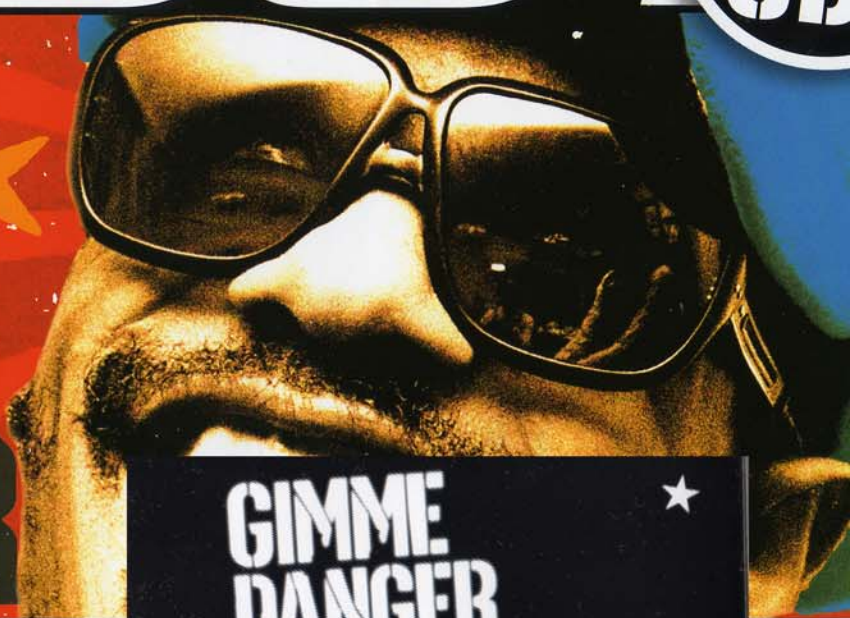

ONE DAY WHEN GOD BEGS MY FORGIVENESS

It's often been said that if Dylan Thomas had been born a generation later, he'd have ended up writing lyrics for a rock band. Songdog mainman Lyndon Morgans is far too modest to put himself in the same league as the legendary Welshman, but he hails from the same part of the world, and when he's not working with his Welsh trio he's pursuing a parallel career as a playwright/novelist. "One Day..." is the opening track from the band's first album for One Little Indian, and is typical of the record's juxtaposition of profound ideas and affecting stories set against the most delicately formed musical backdrops.
