Are you interested in a limited registration or a full registration?

Do you understand the difference between a limited registration and a full registration?

Do you understand that by placing a deposit on an un-born litter you are taking the risk of not getting the desired puppy in a specific time frame, if either the desired sex is not produced or if the litter does not take, (as these events are out of my control) then you will have to wait until an alternate litter of your choosing has been born. And that I also cannot guarantee how many litters it will take to produce the desired puppy?

Do you understand that your deposit will only hold your puppy through 8 weeks of

age (12 weeks for Service Dog contracts), and that we will require a boarding fee after the agreed upon pick up date?

Do you agree to keep the dog on heart worm preventive?

Do you agree to keep the dog on flea care?

Do you agree to keep the dog on a high quality dog food for its entire life. (We recommend Purina Pro Plan, Royal Canin, or Hills Science Diet)

Do you understand that the dog is to be an inside dog only?

Do you understand that once you place a deposit, it is absolutely non-refundable?

Do you understand that any money received is non-refundable and will only go toward the purchase of your puppy, which

will be honored indefinitely but not refunded for any reason even if you decide not to purchase a puppy?

Do you understand that you may never sell or find a new home for the puppy or adult...if the placement does not work for any reason he/she will come back to me?

Do you understand that I can void this contract and refuse to sell you a puppy for any reason I feel is necessary, to include but not limited to distrust of your intentions toward my puppy or breeding lines and no money will be refunded?

Do you agree to not abuse or neglect this dog, and that if at any time I, the Breeder, believes this dog is abused or neglected or if you break this contract, that I have the right to reposes the dog and that you agree to not seek legal damages against me the breeder or cause the me the breeder legal

expenses?

***Do you agree to not fix your new puppy before 18 months of age, as this can lead to bone cancer and many other problems and will void the health guarantee. If you feel you must get the Collie altered before that, we highly suggest an Ovary Sparing Spay (OSS) or Vasectomy. While it is more expensive, it is healthier.

Do you agree to not for any reason cause legal damages against me the breeder?

Will you sell a puppy to owners, if it is to be an outside dog?

Do you understand that my puppies and grand puppies are to only be sold as inside pets?

Will you sell your puppies on limited and/or full registration...how will you decide if a puppy should be sold on limited or full registration?

Do you understand that all puppies produced by you out of any of my lines are to be sold on limited registration unless they will also agree to the terms in this full reg. contract? to be inside dogs only, to be fixed after the fourth litter for females and

to be fixed at 7 for males, and for puppies to be sold on limited reg. unless these terms are agreed to? (I take my lines and all puppies produced because of me very seriously, and require great responsibility to ensure they are loved and cared for the way all babies (esp. the ones brought into the world by us humans) should be cared for.
