Create heterogeneous student groups	<input type="checkbox"/> Create diverse teams, balanced in RIASEC themes
Create homogeneous students groups	<input type="checkbox"/> Create groups that align RIASEC theme to solve specific types of tasks
Introduce jobs, careers, and community roles	<input type="checkbox"/> Use RIASEC to describe the people and their work
Analyze characters	<input type="checkbox"/> Use RIASEC to describe themes the characters demonstrate
Students reflect on their progress over time	<input type="checkbox"/> Use RIASEC as a way for students to identify with themes in their work and in their experiences
Interview / meet experts	<input type="checkbox"/> Discuss anticipated RIASEC themes; debrief after
Discuss family history or personal biographies	<input type="checkbox"/> Students create a family work-tree (genogram)
Explore “people in the neighborhood”	<input type="checkbox"/> Use RIASEC as a way to map business, leaders, and workers in the community
Student-led conferences	<input type="checkbox"/> Incorporate RIASEC into the process
Project-based learning	<input type="checkbox"/> Include explorations of careers using RIASEC
STEAM activities	<input type="checkbox"/> Organize and/or label the tasks using RIASEC themes
Science lab / experiment	<input type="checkbox"/> Organize and/or label the tasks using RIASEC themes
Field trips	<input type="checkbox"/> Use RIASEC to plan for and reflect on the experience
Use classroom jobs	<input type="checkbox"/> Identify RIASEC themes that align to the jobs
