Hey Y'all! So this might be lengthier than future newsletters as I'm catching up on 6 months of statuses so there's a lot of information to provide. Bear with me!.

You Picked The Wrong Chick was established in February 2022 in honor of my sister, Krista and her courageous fight against cancer. The beneficiaries of YPWC will be multiple women fighting that fight. We want to help as many women as we can, but at this point we have to stay in the NE Indiana region. After more research than I care to relive and multiple meetings with people who have done this longer than me and know WAY more than I do, adjustments to the foundation and its mission have had to be made. YPWC does not provide the "everyday" amenities we initially wanted to because there are already nonprofits in NE Indiana that do that. We are collaborating with those organizations in their efforts. YPWC will provide "Moments of Joy" (think Dates Nights, Spa Days, Road Trips, etc.), along with a gift tote, blanket, and tumbler. Each item being personally run past Krista and approved from a patient's perspective. The idea is for women to take these bags to treatments with them. Each package is worth an estimated \$250. We would never last in the cut throat nonprofit community if we did the same thing as other nonprofits.

Please note that I say the beneficiaries WILL BE because, as you know, we have not provided these gifts and amenities yet, due to multiple changes we have had to make in our mission. All women who submit their stories to us will be recipients of our gifts/amenities. As of now I have 5 stories submitted by 5 wonderful women who are helping YPWC and will be provided a thank you gift very soon.

The fundraising up until this point has been amazing. The Barley Pop, merch sales and online campaigns have been incredible and humbling. It's the only way we are going to succeed, as we built this
