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Work Orders and Scheduling

Review your work

- •Use this guide and the Spring Service Order Form as a checklist for work that needs to be done before launching.
- Schedule an appointment with a customer service representative to meet you on your boat and review your projects.

Make a work plan

- Scheduling and ordering work now is highly recommended.
- Order necessary work from us or set up a schedule to complete the work yourself. Make sure you allow time for inclement weather.
- •Order an engine start. If you order nothing else from Crowley's, you should do this. Having a trained mechanic start and inspect your engine is the best way to minimize last minute surprises and start your season with confidence. Make sure your batteries and keys are onboard.

Select a departure date and time.

•Check with family and friends then schedule a date that you would like to bring the boat to the harbor. Schedule a date as soon as possible. We schedule most spring work based on departure dates. Select a departure time.

Complete the Spring Service Order Form

- Even if you plan on doing all your work yourself you must return the completed Spring Work Order Form to request your departure date and time.
- •Go to www.crowleys.com, download the guide and click on the online form to schedule your departure and order your spring work. Alternatively you can print out the form at the end of this guide and email, mail or hand deliver it to us.
- •To avoid confusion, please only submit one copy.
- If you have any questions about the form or any services we provide, call a customer service representative.

Unscheduled Service Fee:

Please note that standard services requested last minute will be completed only if possible and billed at 1.5 times their regular rate.

Scheduling Procedures


After we receive your *Spring Service Order Form*, we will enter the appropriate work orders and schedule your departure. Please note: Scheduling will be done on a first come, first served basis. **Accounts must be current for us to schedule your departure and spring work.**

Crowley's uses three dates to plan your departure:

DEPARTURE DATE: The date you choose to bring your boat to the harbor. Dockage may be charged if boat remains on our docks three days after scheduled departure

LAUNCH DATE: The day we actually launch your boat. Based on work loads and launch requirements. this day may be up to 5 days prior to your departure date. If your boat is stored inside, we will also set a move date.

MOVE DATE The day we move your boat out of the storage building or to a staging area. For sailboats this date will be 2 weeks prior to your depart date. We will begin moving boats out of inside storage at our discretion starting April 1. If for some reason, you need your boat to remain inside, please contact customer service so they can adjust the schedule to suit your needs. We will contact you to confirm your work orders and departure schedule two weeks prior to your departure date. You should plan to have all of your work complete 48 hours prior to your launch. Rescheduling your departure date after your boat has been staged for launch will result in additional fees. You must settle all outstanding bills with Crowley's prior to departure.



Spring Information



Shrink-wrap Removal

Shrink-wrap removal begins in mid March. If you have any special needs which require your shrink-wrap to stay on longer please contact the Customer Service Department before March 15th.

Keys and Combinations

Make sure you leave us the keys and or combination to any locks for your boat and ladders. we need to access all areas of your boat at launch and will need access for service. Also, We may need to start your boat to move it after it has been launched. If it can not be started please let us know.

Before Launch

- Leave 3 fenders and 4 dock lines in the cockpit for our launching crew.
- If you paint your own bottom, leave a can with a little bottom paint taped to your cradle. We will paint under your pads for you when we launch the boat. If we paint your bottom, we will supply the paint.
- Replace all speedo impellers, reinstall any through hull plugs and seal any through hulls.
- Make sure your safety equipment and registration is current. The Coast Guard and Conservation Police often make spot checks in the spring.
- Leave a set of spare keys for your boat in the office and make sure we have the combination to any locks on the boat. (only the entry key is necessary)
- Check your cradle. The best time to discuss them is while your boat is on the cradle. Contact Customer Service to discuss your needs.

On the Day of Departure

Park your car at the harbor. Use the Metra to get to the yard. You can find a schedule at:

If you leave a car at Crowley's, unload at the docks then please park in the designated area. Arrive one hour prior to your scheduled departure. Bring plenty of water and snacks. Check in with the Dock Master. Settle your service and store accounts at the dock master's shack. Start your engine as soon as possible and let it warm up.

During Your Cruise

Be sure to check the weather forecast and be prepared. You will be on open water. Check in with the Dock Master to find a good time to traverse the river; he will monitor commercial traffic and communicate with the bridges. Do not request a bridge lift for 95th Street. Our dockmaster will call for a lift after all vessels are off the dock. Monitor Channel 16 for Calumet bridges and river traffic. Keep up with other boats while traversing the Calumet River. Keep clear of all commercial traffic. Make sure you avoid the Hyde Park Shoal. The best way to do this is to pass east of the 68th Street Crib. If you have questions, consult a chart. If you feel you need assistance, hire one of Crowley's delivery captains.

Mechanical Services



Engine Start & Inspection

Crowley's engine start & inspection is the best way to minimize last minute surprises and start your season with confidence. After launching, a certified marine mechanic will start and inspect your engine and related systems. A written report is left on your boat for your records. Minor repairs are made if time permits. Otherwise, we will note the discovery on the engine start report and suggest you schedule a harbor call after the spring rush. If a significant problem is discovered during the engine start, we will contact you to discuss your options.

New plugs, wires, caps and rotors are installed to ensure that the ignition system fires properly. The carburetor and timing is adjusted as necessary to aid in quick starts and full power throughout the operating range. **NOTE: Requires an engine start and sea trial - billed separately**.

Atomic 4 and Gas Generator Tune Up

New plugs, wires, caps and rotor, if required, are installed to ensure that the ignition system fires properly. The carburetor and timing are adjusted as necessary to aid in quick starts and full power throughout the operating range. Includes inwater test. NOTE: Requires an engine start - billed separately. \$330

Replace Exterior Anodes

Anti corrosion anodes protect valuable metal components from corrosion. Stray electrical current and galvanic corrosion can do irreparable damage to your propellers shafts, struts, rudders, drives, and other components.

Drive Train Alignment

Engine and shaft alignment are key to smooth powering. Not only is the system adjusted, but other sources of vibration are checked and recommendations are made. If you experienced excessive vibration last year while under power, you are a candidate for this service. **NOTE: Requires an engine start- billed separately**. \$165 / hr

Repack Prop Shaft Stuffing Box

We recommend this service every 3 to 4 years. We repack the stuffing box (where the shaft comes through the hull) before the boat goes into the water. After the boat is launched, a mechanic will run the engine and make adjustments. \$165/ hr

Sea Trial

Our technicians will take your boat out on the water and put her through the paces ensuring it performs as it should. A Sea Trail are required with some engine work and diagnostics. Typically it takes 1 man hour.

Oil and Oil Filter Change

Engines are run in the water and brought up to temperature. We drain and dispose of the old oil and filters and replace them with premium oils and filters meeting or exceeding the manufacturers specifications NOTE:

Paint & Fiberglass Services



Bottom Painting

Crowley's offers a variety of anti-fouling bottom paint options. If you have any questions about which service is right for your boat please don't hesitate to give us a call. Give yourself a break this year; just check the box and let Crowley's handle this dirty chore.

Rolled on Cruising Finish

Our crew will wipe down the existing bottom paint removing any dirt and loose or flaking material. We will carefully mask off the water line, shaft, propeller, depth transducer and any other required components and then roll on one coat of anti-fouling paint. We will paint under the pads and the bottom of the keel prior to launch.

Sprayed Racing Finish

This is the standard finish for a VC17 bottom. Our crew will wipe down your existing bottom paint removing any dirt and loose or flaking material. We will carefully mask off the water line, topsides, shaft, propeller, depth transducer as well as tarping off surrounding boats. We then use professional airless spray equipment to apply a fresh coat of bottom paint. We will paint under the pads and the bottom of the keel prior to launch.

Bottom Prep

Wet sanding, bottom paint removal, keel/hull joint repairs and hull fairing are all routine operations for us. Give us a call to discuss your needs. From a full bottom strip to a #2000 wet sanded finish, Crowley's provides the best.

Gelcoat Touch Ups

If you use your boat, no matter how careful or skilled you are, you will inevitably end up with nicks and gouges in your deck and hull sides. Making repairs to your Gelcoat is a tricky operation. Done incorrectly a repair can look worse than the damage. We employ some of the most skilled craftsmen in the county in this trade. Crowley's routinely does complicated nonskid repairs, color matches and structural glass repairs that other vards will not even attempt. Please note these are weather sensitive repairs. We will make every effort to complete gelcoat touchups, however, inclement weather can sometimes prevent this service from being completed before launch.

Full service mast stepping includes a basic inspection, mast preparation, boom preparation and installation, lighting check, stepping, tuning, taping, completing electrical connections, leading halyards back to the cockpit and rigging the main sheet and traveler.

To Crowley's Lakeside via Lake Shore Drive

Take Lake Shore Drive South to 67th / Marquette Blvd. (just past Jackson Park Harbor) Lake Shore Drive turns into South Shore Drive (Rt 41)

Follow the Rt 41 signs to 95th Street Turn right on 95th Street to Crowley's Yacht Yard entrance, 1 block on the left side of street

To Crowley's Lakeside via I-94/ Skyway

Take I-94 to the Skyway

Exit the Skyway at the 92nd Street (the first exit after you pay the toll)

Left at 92nd Street, go 1 block to South Chicago Blvd

Turn right on South Chicago ½ mile to 95th Street

Turn left on 95th Street, go over the Calumet River on the 95th Street bridge to Crowley's Lakeside.

To Crowley's Lakeside via I-94/Bishop Ford Take I-94 to the North Stony Island to 95th /

Follow the *North Stony Island to 95th* exit sign to the first stop light.

Turn right on 95th Street , proceed approximately 1.5 miles – over the Calumet River to the Crowley's Yacht Yard entrance







