If you are a homeowner in Olde Oaks/Waterford Park, you are an automatic, mandatory member of the Olde Oaks Community Improvement Association (OOCIA) and are encouraged to attend the annual meeting and election of Board directors. The Board consists of five directors who are elected by the Association membership at the Annual Members Meeting held every second Wednesday of February. Of the five directors, three are elected in even numbered years and two are elected in odd numbered years; thus, three directors will be elected at our Annual Members' Meeting to be held on February 14, 2018. Members interested in running for a position are encouraged to contact Crest Management for an application to complete and return. Crest will give a copy to the Nominating Committee. The Nominating Committee can assist candidates in getting a short bio into the February newsletter if submitted by the January 10 newsletter deadline, organizing a "meet and greet" for all candidates at the end of the January monthly Board meeting, and answering any questions. We know serious candidates want to have their information available for voters as soon as possible to allow members to make informed decisions. Candidates may also have their bios placed on the website. To be a director, an applicant must be a member of the Association. In addition, if the Association can be given proof that a director has been convicted of a felony or crime

of moral turpitude they are disqualified from continued or future service on a board. All applications must be received by Crest by 4 p.m. Friday, January 10. Late applicants may still volunteer to run for the Board "from the floor" at the Annual Members' Meeting.

If you have any questions or would like more information about the position of a director, feel free to ask any Board member or Crest Management for current information and help in the process.





The January book is a memoir about Trevor's growing up as a mixed-race child first under South African apartheid and then in its wake. It is partly a tribute to his black mother, partly an indictment of white oppressors, and reveals how he bridged the race gap. This vibrant setting of Johannesburg takes place in the '80s, '90s, and beyond. Noah's mother and Swiss father were never married, but his father wanted to be part of his life after Trevor was born in 1984. The family faced and navigated many challenges on top of the usual hardships faced by blacks at that time and place. Noah is presently known as an international comedian, political commentator, and as a television host for *The Daily Show* on Comedy Central since 2015. He speaks six languages and has become one of the best exports of South Africa.
