Highland Lutheran Church Council Meeting April 10, 2022

Call to Order

The April 10, 2022 meeting of the Highland Lutheran Church council was called to order by President Joyce Bjerke at approximately 9:37 a.m. Others in attendance were: Virginia Karlsbroten, Mark Sollien, Secretary Danny Dutka, Treasurer Anna Jetson, Darlene Sollien, Karen Erickson.

Secretary Report

Danny Dutka read the minutes of the March 6, 2022 meeting. Moved by Karen Erickson, seconded by Darlene Sollien to approve the minutes as read. Motion carried by voice vote.

Treasurer Report

Anna Jetson provided printed and verbal information on the finances of the church. Balances as of April 3, 2022 are: Current \$7,158.32, Benevolence \$246.00, Anniversary Fund \$365.10, Improvement Fund \$65,445.96, Scholarship Fund \$5860.99. The Lenten offerings are designated to go to ELCA Disaster Relief. Since we are not having some of the Wednesday evening services a question arose as to whether the offerings are comparable to past years. This will be reviewed again after Easter. The printed Treasurer reports will be filed for audit.

Other

Danny Dutka stated that he has hired Ward Budweg to replace the east window of the addition, has contacted Jake's Roofing to get an estimate / proposal to fix the roof leak at the bell tower area and had previously contacted Driftless Gardens of Decorah to give a proposal to update the landscaping at the north door. Still waiting for responses from the latter two. He noted that Henzlers seem to have closed and asked for names of other landscapers in the area. Pinter's and Ladybug Landscapes were suggested.

Virginia Karlsbroten has spoken with two area Pastors who are willing to provide coverage for funerals in case Pastor Gies is unavailable.

Mark Sollien who is on the Cemetery Committee stated that Total Lawn Care will be doing the mowing this season. Bob Maroushek had previously informed the Committee that he would no longer be able to do the mowing.

Membership Review

The membership ledger has been obtained from the office at Big Canoe. There appears to be omissions and outdated information. Anna has started recording information in a database so that it can be more easily reviewed. Virginia and Darlene have volunteered to compose a letter that will be sent out to gather information and encourage participation in Highland church life.

Adjournment

Due to the late hour a motion to adjourn was made by Karen Erickson and seconded by Danny Dutka. Motion carried by voice vote.

Big Canoe Council Meeting, Tuesday, April 12, 2022

The Big Canoe Church Council met on April 12, 2022 for its regular monthly meeting. Members in attendance were President Pat O'Regan, Treasurer Laurie Emery, Bill Stone, Vern Whitaker, Rita Thomas, Liz Schafer and Shelly Bigler. Rita led us in devotions from Ps. 100.

The secretary's report was approved as read and placed on file.

The treasurer reported a quarterly balance of \$11,367.99 on hand and all bills paid. The parsonage account has a balance of \$3,330.98. The Lenten collection will be donated to the Decorah Community Food Pantry by unanimous consent of the council.

Our Tuck Point project was discussed. The southwest corner of the church and the south wall under the facia are in very poor shape. Before we get further bids, it was decided that we meet and look over the entire exterior of the church for any other work that may need to be done. The congregation is invited to help us on April 24 after worship.

Permanent replacements of the alter candles was discussed. Currently we are using disposable candles and they have to be replaced frequently to the tune of \$90 every three months. Funds have been secured to purchase permanent, refillable candles at an approximate price of \$900.

The Easter Breakfast and pie auction were discussed.

The Sunday School checking account needs to have its checking account signers updated. Motioned by Liz and seconded by Vern, approved by unanimous consent that the list of signers be updated to include Tammy Nordheim, Ashley Borresen or Shelly Bigler, the current Sunday School Committee members.

The Luther League checking account signers will also be updated. Motioned by Liz and seconded by Vern, approved by unanimous consent that Tammy Nordheim or Shelly Bigler be allowed to write checks from the Luther League account.

The Congregational financial and stewardship report has been sent to the synod by Pat. We discussed changing how we handle our money. Most of it is in CDs which are paying nothing. No conclusion was reached.

The Council will meet June 5 after church to discuss and make final adjustment to the Call Packet before it is sent to the synod.

Inspection of the Parsonage will be on June 1 after the renters move out. If approved, they will receive their deposit back.

The GeoParish newspaper was briefly discussed and items mentioned to be submitted to it.

The Nathan Borresen Fund raiser was discussed. Motioned by Rita, seconded by Liz and approved by unanimous consent that the Social Concerns Committee will sponsor the event to be held on June 5, 2022. Mike Reicks Chicken will cater the event and tickets will be \$15/ meal. Tickets should be available by May 15.

It was brought to the attention of the Council there were not enough handicap spots in front of the church. We discussed designating at least three more handicap parking spots. Council agreed it is a good idea and we will pursue what needs to be done.

It has also been mentioned to the Council that we designate a Sunday, perhaps in the fall, that members be invited to drive their antique cars to church and others be invited to bring they're antique cars or trucks to join us. More discussion will be held next month.

The Crandle memorial burial pall dedication will be held June 6.

Vanco automatic withdrawal giving was tabled until our May meeting.

Motioned by Liz and seconded by Vern that we adjourn with the Lord's Prayer. Vern led the prayer and the meeting was adjourned.
