Hello Dear Patron,

We are gearing up for our Ssgt John H Templon Annual Golf Outing on Saturday, September 9th at the Sinking Valley Country Club and would love your help keeping our tradition alive! VFW Post #3 is one of the oldest posts in the country and began in Altoona in 1914! For over 100 years we have been in our community helping local veterans find comradery and safety among their brothers and sisters across all the branches of our military.

As the landscape of Altoona has changed, Post #3 has weathered it's fair share of hard times; including the loss of our building in downtown Altoona. Although at the time, the sale of the dilapidated building felt like the most pragmatic move, the effects 15 years later have truly been felt. No longer do we have a space for service men and women to meet, no longer is there a space to provide a steady income for the club and our philanthropic duties and no longer is their space to publicly display the grand history of Post #3 and it's decades of members.

Our aim is work towards finding a solution to our conundrum, while still providing support for veterans and veteran oriented projects throughout Blair County. The annual golf outing is our biggest fundraiser of the year. Last year we were able to net \$6,000 with the support of our community sponsors! We funded some notable projects with those donations including...

- The installation of a bench in Veterans Mall in Downtown Altoona honoring the late John F. Gority, our beloved Post Commander and purple heart recipient who was laid to rest in Arlington Cemetery in 2022
- Memorial Day activities including flags marking the graves of veterans in The Oak Ridge Cemetery and Wreath Laying Ceremonies at multiple Veteran Memorials throughout Altoona
- The reconstruction of a flagpole at the historic Fort Roberdeau, an Eagle Scout project
- A sponsorship for a team in The East End Little League Association
- And arguably the most important contribution, our emergency grant fund for veterans in distress
