2023 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Sampson-Webber (Gleaners) Distributed 731 non-perishable food packages to 573 families.
- Thanksgiving Boxes Delivered to 115 home-bound seniors and distributed 160 to the homeless. Both through partnership with St. Leo's Kitchen, and Tabernacle Missionary Baptist Church drivers.
- Diaper & Incontinence Program Served 447 families through partnership with Metro. Detroit Diaper Bank.
- Angel Tree Program Distributed 90
 Christmas gifts to children of incarcerated parents.
- S.W. Community Court Provided community service and counseling to 25 individuals.
- Ministered to **3,360** Macomb Prison Inmates on Sunday Services.

- COVID Vaccination 7 patients in partnership with Judson Center, and Det. Equity Coalition.
- Donated 50 backpacks to Mt. Sion Missionary Baptist Church & Sampson-Webber Academy

Giving Glory to God and Congratulating Rev. Samuel Spruill for his vision of a Faith-Based In-House Mentorship Program was approved by the Warden of Macomb Correctional Facility. The first class of this magnitude ever in Michigan's prison system was rolled out in Nov. 2023 to 10 participants with the assistance of Rev. Spruill's partner in Prison Ministry, Elder Orlando Gregory.
