Public Safety Radio Dispatcher Trainee (PSRDT) is the entry-level training classification for a career in public safety dispatching within the City of San José. As a PSRDT, you are provided with formal training, both in the classroom and in the Communications Center, to develop the knowledge and skills necessary to perform the full range of public safety dispatching functions. Trainees must successfully complete all formal academic and on-the-job training to be appointed to the class of PSRD and retain their employment.
