

Lake of the Woods County Fair Oval Race Rules 2024

- In 2024 all vehicle types (4cy, 6/8cy and RWD Cars will race together) in both the Bush and Powderpuff Divisions. No trucks in 2024.
- A 2- or 4-point cage is highly recommended but optional for cars. Cage must be bolted to the floor and ceiling of the vehicle. Halo bars are recommended and encouraged.
- Driver's door reinforcement is required. A fence post in the door frame will be acceptable.
- Glass may be left in but secured. Minivans must have all glass removed before entering the infield other than windshield. If windshield is removed must have something covering the driver's area of the windshield (example: Chicken Wire)
- Must have working seat belts. Headers are allowed. Helmets and eye protection are mandatory.
- Vehicles must have working breaks
- Sunroofs must be removed and covered with sheet metal and properly secured.
- No weight may be added to the vehicle. No trailer hitches are allowed.
- Radios(spotters) ARE allowed
- Any factory bumper will be allowed. Homemade bumpers are allowed but must not have sharp edges or a fabricated point. Bumpers may not expand farther than the outside of the front tires.
- Vehicles must have standard DOT tires. Wheel weights must be removed before passing tech.
- Vehicles with rear wheel drive must have mud flaps that extend to the ground when the race starts
- Slogans, advertising and printing may be placed on vehicles. The vehicle number must be printed on both sides of the vehicle and must have a roof sign. No profanity is allowed on the vehicles. If you do not have a roof sign one will be provided for you.
- Top 3 in each division MUST pass a post-race inspection in the infield following the checkered flag in their respective features. Cars may not return to the pit area before inspection occurs.
- Vehicles must be removed from the infield area within 72 hours of the conclusion of the event or they will become property of The Lake of the Woods County Fair board
- Vehicles must enter the infield via the southeast gate of the racetrack. Registration and tech will take place at this time. Tech will take place from 3pm-5:30 pm on the day of the event. Heats will be determined by random draw prior to drivers meeting approx. 45 minutes before the race.
- Pit gates will be closed once the event starts and will remain shuttered until the conclusion of the event. If you need to leave early please tell an official before exiting the infield area. Anyone not in compliance of this rule will be subject to removal and a 1- year ban from competing at the fairgrounds.
- No one under the age of 16 is allowed in the infield during the show
- Female drivers must declare for **EITHER** the bush race or the powderpuff division. If planning on entering both divisions, the driver must have a separate vehicle for each division and entry fees paid separately.
- Rough and over-aggressive driving will not be tolerated. The demo is 7pm the night after the races if you want to be aggressive.
