REFRIGERATOR OR FREEZER	\$35.00
AIR CONDITIONER OR DEHUMIDIFIER	\$25.00
WASHER, DRYER, DISHWASHER OR STOVE	\$5.00
LIGHT BULBS Fluorescent tubes, Compact fluorescent bulbs Ultraviolet lamps, LED lamps	\$1.00 Each UNBROKEN LIGHT TUBES ONLY NEVER DISPOSE IN DUMPSTER
SCRAP METAL Metal cookware, wiring, hitches, lawn chairs, treadmills, bikes, lawn mowers, metal cages or traps, bicycles	NO FEE PLACE IN SCRAP TRAILER NO PROPANE TANKS OR CYLINDERS

RECYCLABLES

ALL RESIDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO RECYCLE

Materials identified as recyclable SHOULD NOT be placed in dumpsters with household waste!!

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED AT THE TOWN DROP-OFF SITE

Note: Due to cost increases and handling issues with certain items, we have added to the items not accepted at the drop site.

PRINTER, COPIER OR FAX	
VCR, DVD PLAYER, DVR, SPEAKERS	
SMALL APPLIANCES	Vacuum cleaners, coffee makers, blenders, radios, fans, toasters, toaster ovens, space heaters, etc
CARPETING	
CONSTRUCTION OR REMODELING DEBRIS	Glass, brick, concrete, lumber, drywall, insulation, wiring, piping, sinks, toilets, cabinetry
LIGHT BALLASTS	
DOORS, WINDOWS, SIDING, ROOFING	
FURNITURE	Chairs, sofas, dressers, desks, tables, chairs, entertainment centers, etc
LEAD ACID BATTERIES	Car, power tools, etc

THE FOLLOWING ARE NOT TO BE DISPOSED IN DUMPSTERS AND LANDFILLED PLEASE FOLLOW RECOMMENDATIONS FOR DISPOSAL

YARD WASTE	Consider composting. The WI DNR web-site is a resource for composting information.
HAZARDOUS WASTE: Enamel & Oil Based Paints, Pesticides, Kerosene, Gasoline, Chemicals, Varnish, Thinner, Stripper, Automotive Fluids and Cleaners, Lithium Batteries, Mercury	See Dodge or Jefferson County Web-sites for Clean Sweep dates and details regarding hazardous items
LP TANKS	Ask about disposal options when purchasing or return to place of purchase DO NOT DISPOSE IN SCRAP TRAILER OR TRASH DUMPSTER

THE FOLLOWING MAY BE DISPOSED IN HOUSEHOLD TRASH DUMPSTERS, BUT CONSIDER THE FOLLOWING RECYCLING OPTIONS:

- **PLASTIC BAGS AND WRAP ARE RECYCLABLE** - While they are not allowed in the Recycle Dumpster, you can take them to a retailer near you and deposit in bins provided. Walmart, Kohls and Pick N Save are a few of the local retailers that have bins available.
- **WORN OUT CLOTHING AND TEXTILES ARE RECYCLABLE** – If you have items that are too worn to donate or sell, you can recycle them. If you take them to St. Vincent DePaul, for example, just let the attendant know that the items are not in saleable condition. They will place them in their recycle trailer and receive a cash benefit from recycling them.
