i. GM, Walker reported that Redwood Valley County Water District will receive a cost reduction of roughly \$6,000 per month. Willow's MSA and the fees associated with them work for a year in the rears. There was an increase in 2022 to cover the additional hours spent on the Water Infrastructure Retrofit Project, the reduction for 2023 is based on those hours being reduced.

c. Update on Drought and Water Conservation Efforts

- ii. 28 inches of rainfall since October 1, 2022.
- iii. The latest report from the State is that much of California will still remain in drought status.

d. Report on JPA and Consolidation Efforts

- ii. Next Ad Hoc meeting at the end of this month and GM, Walker reports that the discussions look to be heading in the right direction.
