Public Forum

- Director Nevill made a motion to move New Business item C. Consideration of Connection Fee Deferment for Bella Vista Subdivision to Public Forum.
 - Jake Morley, the Project Manager for the Bella Vista Subdivision, addressed the board requesting to defer payments of service connection fees. He states that they would like to pay the fees out of escrow as opposed to paying up front.
 - The board will further discuss the proposal and will bring it back to the next meeting.

Staff Reports

a. General Manager

- i. GM, Walker reported that he had received an email from Russian River Flood Control stating that there would be an increase in water rates from \$47 to \$68 per acre foot starting at the beginning of the next contract year. This will be a 40% increase; it has been around 10+ years since they have increased their water rates.
- ii. The Russian River Water Forum has an upcoming meeting this Thursday from 10 am to 1 pm either via zoom or in-person.
 - 1. Discussions were being had regarding the proposal for PG&E draft license surrender decommissioning project between Sonoma Water Agency, Mendocino County Inland Water and Power Commission, and Round Valley Indian Tribes.
 - 2. There were also conversations of alternative plans that have been discussed previously.
 - 3. Rumors of lowering Van Arsdale Reservoir about 15 to 20 feet in elevation.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Chris Watt stated that PG&E was willing to receive a proposal in regards decommissioning project from anyone that wants all or part of the project. Over the last six months the RRWF has been working in confidence with PG&E to figure out what that statement meant exactly. Sonoma Water, Inland Power, and the Round Valley Indian Tribes put together this proposal stating they have interest in forming a regional entity that could continue the diversion.
