We require a \$25 deposit to hold your spot. All processing is done by appointment. You can call 949-400-4225 or email us at ranchhand@followthesheepwalk.com. Customers will be assigned a date or dates based on what's available. Our turn around is currently approximately 8 weeks.

Carding/Felting

- Based on washed weight, but grease weight will be noted.
- We will let you know if we have to skirt heavily and what the "loss" is.
- Heavy skirting will be \$5/lb but we will let you know if we need to do this.
- Price includes tumbling, washing, picking/fiber separating except if you are wash only.
- **Prices are per POUND.**

Other Notes

- Prices are subject to change without notice.
- CPP is the Cost Per Pound.
- Customers will be given a date when their fiber should arrive at the mill. This means that is your time slot for processing.
- **We cater to small and medium flock raisers** but will have space for customers with acquired fleece to process.
- Projects exceeding 60 pounds may require extended processing time due to the care we provide with each and every ounce.
- A \$25.00 fee will be charged for all return checks.
- Outstanding accounts will be assessed a 2% charge per month on any balance due over 30 days. After 90 days, items from accounts unpaid will become the property of The Sheepwalk Fiber Mill, LLC.

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Spinning

- Based on washed weight, but grease weight will be noted.
- We will let you know if we have to skirt heavily and what the “loss” is.
- Heavy skirting will be \$5/lb but we will let you know if we need to do this.
- Price includes tumbling, washing, picking/fiber separator, draw frame, spinning, plying and skein/cones.
- **Prices are per POUND.**

Note for Suri: A \$5 service will be applied for removal of heavy veggie matter. We do recommend a 10% Blend with Merino BUT it is not necessary. No two fleeces are alike.

** Not all fiber will qualify for lace. We will discuss this if issue arises. Let us know if you are wanting “tapestry” yarn, gauge and ply. We will swatch out the fiber to make sure it can handle the spin.*

** All skeins will be washed once for final rinse and set.*

- If blending your own fibers together just let us know what ratios you think you want. 70% fiber A 30% fiber B (example). Please do not put them in the same bag. Just make sure you mark the bags as 1 of 2 and 2 of 2.

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Co-Op Pricing 2023

\$5-8 per pound for raw fleece for medium to coarse wool

This can include heritage shetland, jacob, gulf coast, awassi, karakul and churro. Fleece price is based on quality and condition.

\$7-10 per pound for raw fleece for untested fine to light medium wool

This can include rambouillet, suffolk, hampshire, debouillet, delaine, and so on. Fleece price is based on quality and condition.



For camelid and mohair, prices can be negotiated. We also offer Co-Op trades where you give 50% donated and get product back that is 100% yours OR we blend with same or other fibers to create a unique product that represents Texas. You will receive product in return as well. We will try to match product to your interests or needs!

- No Deposit is required when your fleece arrives at our mill. 2-3 Weeks before your fiber is scheduled to go into processing, you will receive an estimate, and a deposit of \$50 will be required to hold your spot. This payment will be deducted from final bill.
- Turn around times are not guaranteed. We make every effort to set realistic expectations, however, there are too many variable to guarantee turn around times.
- Deposits not received within 30 days of initial request may be put back to the bottom of the waiting list. We will make sure that you are ready to process because life can throw us curve balls! Deposits not paid within 6 months of initial request will not be processed. Customers will be responsible for all shipping fees to and from the mill.
- Outstanding accounts will be assessed a 2% charge per month on any balance due over 30 days. After 90 days, items from accounts unpaid will become the property of The Sheepwalk Fiber Mill LLC.
- If you choose to cancel your order then you will be 100% responsible of the cost to get that fiber back to you. We will send you an estimate from pirateship.com if you need help on this.
- **All fiber must be skirted and sorted prior to arriving at the our mill. All unskirted/ unsorted fiber will be charged a \$5 per pound fee and we will let you know if something can't be processed or if it can only go to certain end stage.**

Remember that our equipment is not designed to get all vegetable matter and second cuts out. We will do the best to get your fiber picked, but we humans and our equipment can only do so much!

Shipping to and from The Sheepwalk Fiber ill LLC is the responsibility of the owner. Items will ship the same week cleared final payment is received. You may request finished orders be delivered to a show we plan to attend and raw fiber may be picked up at shows we attend. *No additional charges for show pick up and drop off.*
