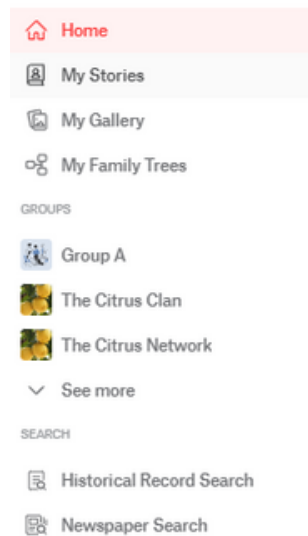

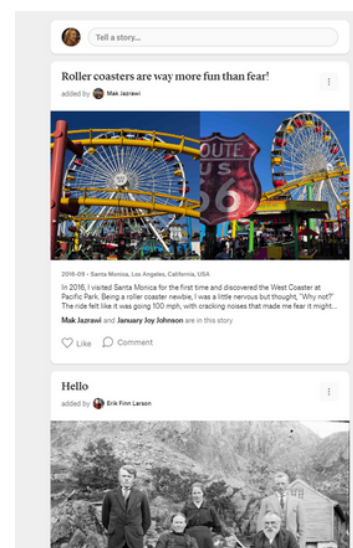

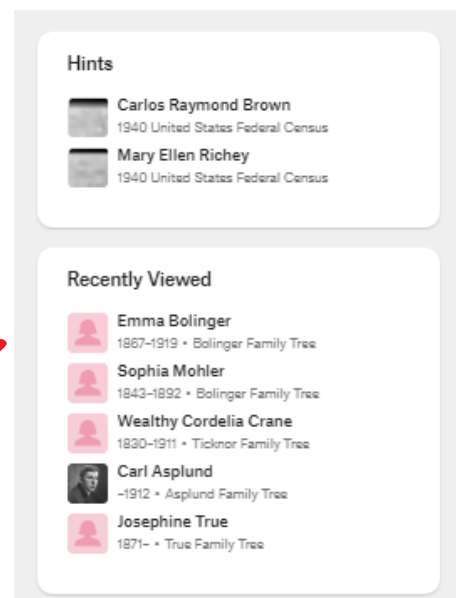
The STORY FEED consists of the stories published by people you follow. The top ones are the most recent. It's just a snippet of the whole story.



The SIDE NAVIGATION (on the left of the home page) gives you quick access to different parts of Storied. From the side navigation panel, you can go to My Stories, My Gallery, My Family Trees, Groups, or Search Historical Records and Newspapers.



To the right of your story feed are two additional features to make navigating and adding to your family tree quick and easy - HINTS and RECENTLY VIEWED. Any available Hints found for people in your family tree will be noted here. Recently Viewed allows you to quickly access the last five people you viewed. And they can be from different family trees!

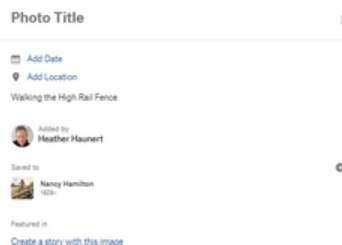

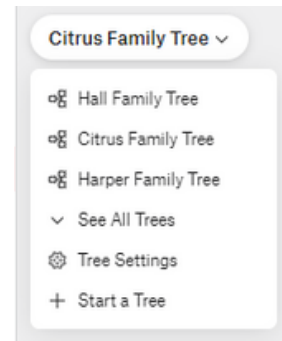

If you have multiple family trees, you can view a list of all of them by clicking My Family Trees, using the drop down arrow by the current tree name, and choosing SEE ALL TREES.



Tree Tasks

Complete the following tasks to get started with your family tree.

When you start a new family tree, Storied creates TREE TASKS to motivate you to add basic information about the first three generations.

When you are in the tree view, you have several actions you can do by clicking on an individual...view profile, view tree, quick edit, add family, search records, stories, and gallery.

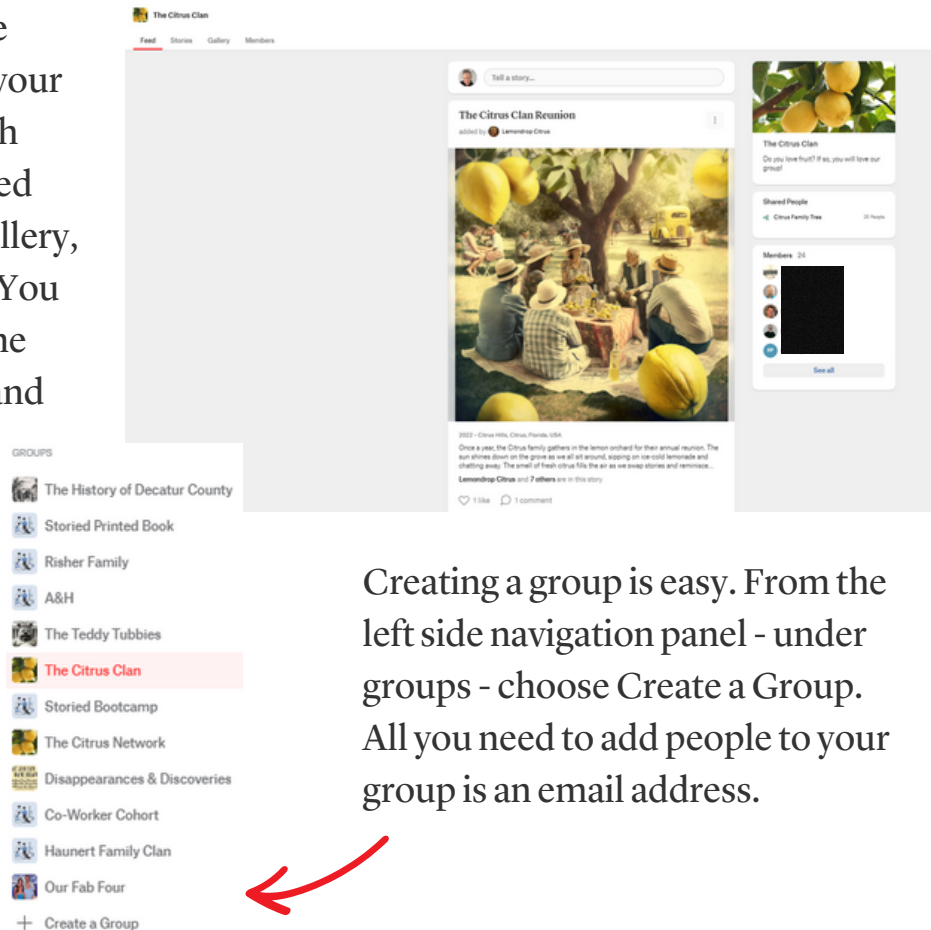

Share stories with the important people in your life with Groups. Each group has a specialized story feed, stories, gallery, and list of members. You can also customize the URL for your group and share a family tree.

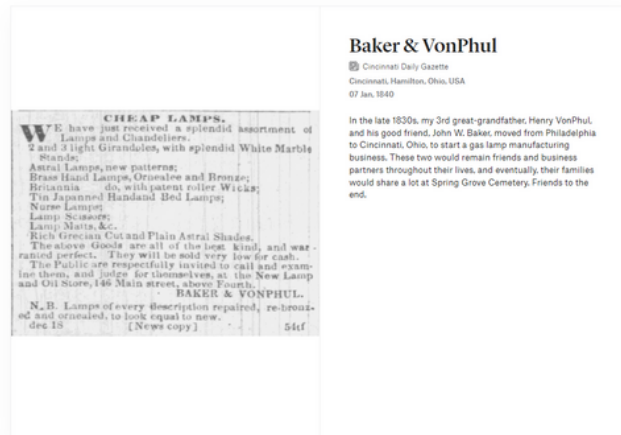
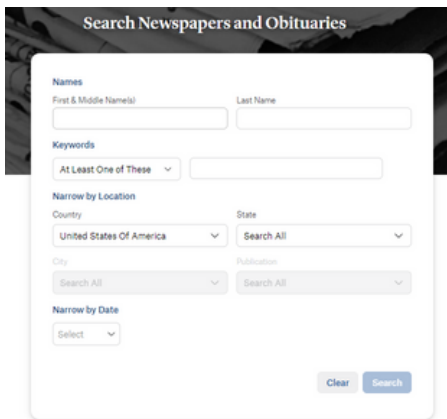
There are two types of searches at Storied. The Historical Record Search gives a user basic and advanced search options for all kinds of records: census, birth, marriage, death, military, and immigration.

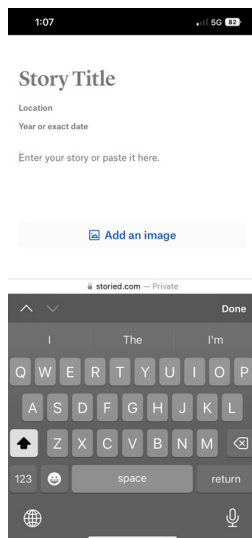
