been wormed at least twice with Panacur but a fecal exam should still be done at 1st Veterinarian visit.

Welfare:

This Puppy will be housed indoors and only taken outside for exercise and to relieve itself. Bulldogs can experience breathing issues in the extreme heat which can prove to be deadly. If the breeder discovers that the Puppy is being neglected or abused in any way, the breeder will take possession of the Puppy.

Buyer agrees to exercise normal care in maintaining this Bulldog's health. Routine preventative care including annual physical exams, annual vaccinations against DHLPP and Rabies. Prevention against Heartworm and Lymes is recommended.

BUYERS AGREE TO NEVER SELL THIS BULLDOG. If at anytime the buyer does not want or can not keep this Bulldog, the Bulldog will be returned with its AKC papers and signed transfer. The breeder will take this Bulldog and care for him until a suitable home is found and the Bulldog is placed, free to the new home. If the Bulldog is given away or sold the buyer must agree to compensate the breeder for Legal Fees and other costs associated with the recovery of this Bulldog.

There will be NO SURGERIES performed on this Bulldog without contact breeder. If necessary the breeder will pay for a second opinion by her Veterinarian to prevent any harmful treatment. Euthanasia is never allowed except in an emergency case and breeder must be notified. Breeder is responsible and does not want any of her babies ending up in a shelter, rescue or put to sleep. THE GOAL AND FULL INTENT IS TO HAVE THIS BULLDOG FOR HIS NATURAL LIFETIME.
