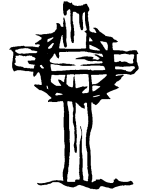

John 13:1-17, 31b-35

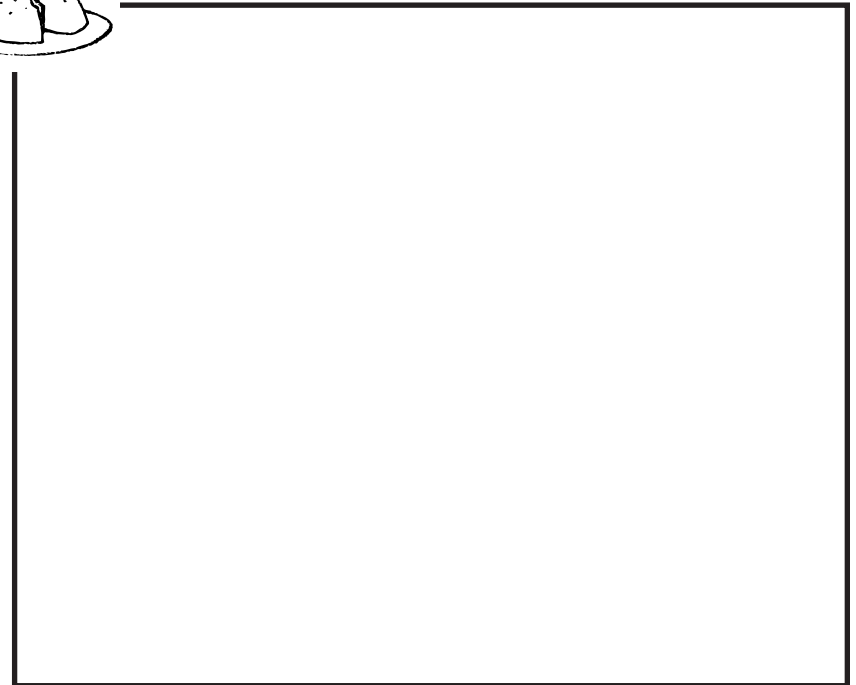

When he finished he said, "Just as I have washed your feet, you can wash each other's feet. Do as I have done to you." The disciples were surprised when Jesus washed their feet, because that was a job that was usually done by a servant.
