Dear faithful friends and fellow children of God: though times change, God remains our source of assurance.

Sunday, June 6th will mark a month of our resumption of indoor worship. Due to the continued improvement in health conditions in our area, I am excited to announce that the church council has elected to discontinue the two-group system for worship attendance based on last names. In other words, as of June 6th, all members may attend each Sunday service as they feel comfortable. We are so glad that our efforts as a congregation, in particular, our patience and adherence to health guidance, have allowed us to get to this point. We will, of course maintain all of our proper health precautions such as masking, social distancing, and maintaining sanitization. Through these continued precautions and God's guidance, we will hopefully continue in our improving trajectory and be able to take further steps towards restoring pre-pandemic elements of our church we cherish. Your continued patience, assistance, and increasing participation in church ministries and activities will be the key to seeing us reach our goals all the sooner.

Speaking of activities, as you may have seen or heard, our area of the Pacifica Synod, the Raincross Conference, is gathering together for an inter-congregational opportunity for community and conversation. We already have some members from our congregation of Faith who are interested in partnering and participating in this great ministry. Using a curriculum from Augsburg Press called "Dialogues on Race", pastors and members will gather virtually for 8 weeks to tackle the difficult topic of race and how it affects our lives and our faith. The context of these conversations within a church setting allows the opportunity to transform from potential conflict into a growing community. There is a TBD small registration cost, but don't let that deter you from this great opportunity to have honest and open conversations about race within the context of faith and with faithful people. This class will begin later in the summer or fall and we are in the initial stage of gathering interest so please let me or the office know if you are interested in participating or for more information.

Finally, in these changing times as we are able to do more and more, if there is a new ministry opportunity you would like to bring to the church or one which has gone dormant during our time of the pandemic, stand up and speak up for them. This is a crucial time when we can reengage and get more involved with the church, allowing our ministries to thrive again. And we cannot do so without your passion and participation. So I urge you to take a look at our

congregation and our ministries and see where you would like to get more involved and how we can share God's grace and good news more in these ways. I look forward to seeing you there!

So, until we see each other again: "May the Lord bless you and keep you; may the Lord make his face shine on you and be gracious to you; may the Lord turn his face toward you and give you peace." (Numbers 6:24-26).


# Beginning June 6<sup>th</sup> we will no longer be divided into two groups. Everyone may worship every Sunday!!

# FINANCIAL REPORT Ending April 30, 2021

#### a. Offering Envelopes

- i) For the month, we are again below budget at 91.7% (\$9,818 vs \$10,714).
- ii) **Year-to-date,** we are slightly under budget at 97.9% (\$43,824 vs \$44,749).

#### b. Total Income

- i) For the month, well above budget at 146.8% (\$23,258 vs \$15,845).
- ii) Year-to-date, significantly above budget at 121.8% (\$70,764 vs \$58,108).

#### c. Expenses

- i) For the month, under budget at 92.7% (\$13,780 vs \$14,862).
- ii) Year-to-date, under budget at 92.6% (\$57,490 vs \$62,119).
- d. **Net Operating Income** (Total Income minus Expenses)
  - i) For the month, significantly over budget with a profit of \$9.78, vs. the expected profit of \$983.
  - ii) **Year-to-date,** much better than expected with a profit of \$13,274, vs. the expected loss of \$4,011.

#### e. **Checking balance**

- i) Balance at Month-end is \$29,714.
- ii) Previous Month-end balance was \$19,655.

#### f. <u>Comments</u>

- i) Although we started out above budget for January and February, both March and April Offerings are below budget, and we are slightly below budget YTD.
- ii) Total Income and Net Operating expenses are way above budget due to \$15,000 in Special Offerings from deceased member. These gifts help our overall financial situation, but member giving continues to fall short of our conservative budget expectations.
- iii) Although Income was below budget, Expenses were also below budget, resulting in a modest profit for the month. For the year, Net Operating Income (Income minus Expenses) is well above budget, due to below budget Expenses and the Special Offerings in January from a deceased member.
- iv) Thanks to all who contributed to the Long Term Property Fund from their Stimulus checks. We raised a total of \$7,355.30.
- v) Thanks to all who contributed to our Technology Fund. As a result, we were able to secure a 50% matching grant of \$850 to help offset the cost of improvements for our Drive-in and online services, as well as improve our in-person worship experience.


