Dear faithful friends and fellow children of God: Let's dance!

Even for those of us, like me, who do not relish the prospect of actual dancing, the concept of life's journey being like a dance can be helpful. This conceptualization is especially comforting to think about when we think about the fact that the dance was started, invented, and continues through the Holy Trinity, which means that our God is our constant dance partner throughout all of life. This absolutely and especially includes the past year and a half, and through this recent surge of the pandemic.

One of amazing things about the Lord of the Dance is that God has taught all of us a few new dance moves in the last 18 months, even people like me who are what you might call "dance averse." In this case it means we've learned how to worship in new ways and new places while praising the same God with the same community of faith. With virtual, recorded worship and praising in the parking lot, to being back inside with face coverings, it is the same dance of worship and praise with new steps intermingling with the familiar ones. To be sure, some of these changes have led to some stepped on toes, miscommunications while learning the new steps, and yet I am so incredibly proud of this church for trusting in the Lord of the Dance to keep the beat and the dance going, even in these recent unharmonious times. I am so honored to be serving you all in this time, learning these steps right along with you and doing what I can to help encourage us all through the words of our God and other children of God. And I know that it is hard, to keep it all up, the energy and tempo, the consistency of doing things differently than we would ideally like to do them, to have this changed pattern of our faith life continue longer than we ever expected it to. It can be very draining, even discouraging.

And yet it is at that very moment that we remember who is dancing with us, who will never tire and will never stop grabbing our hand and hauling us back up on our feet, energizing us with their sheer enthusiasm for the dance and for us. The Trinity in their mysterious ways want us to succeed, want us to keep going, and give us what we need to keep dancing far longer than we would ever expect of ourselves. After all, as the song says, "the Three, in hope and love, made room within their dance." God made room for you, made a space on the dance floor and at the table for you, so keep going, keep dancing, keep praising, keep seeking new ways to dance and add to the great movement of souls with is our faith. Keep joining in with your community for worship. Remember we still have many ways in which to do just that, the different dance moves we've learned still work, join us inside with masks, if not inside then in the parking lot via radio station FM 98.9, or of course

online. So let's dance, whichever method you feel most comfortable with, how ever you choose to dance, know that we dance with you.

So, until we see each other again: "May the Lord bless you and keep you; may the Lord make his face shine on you and be gracious to you; may the Lord turn his face toward you and give you peace." (Numbers 6:24-26).

This policy is necessary for us to continue having in-person gatherings and we appreciate your participation and understanding. If you forget to bring your mask, please ask and one will be given to you.
- Executive Council has decided to continue Confirmation classes but pause all other Sunday School classes. We will also discontinue the Children's Chat during the service, for now.

September's "God's Work. Our Hands" was a success. We gave 60 Hygiene Kits to the Menifee Police Department to distribute to the homeless. Thank you so much to everyone who donated and helped assemble the kits. \*See photos on page 8

#### **FINANCIAL REPORT**

#### Ending August 31, 2021

#### a. Offering Envelopes

- i) For the month, we are below budget at 93.8% (\$10,107 vs \$10,781).
- ii) **Year-to-date,** we are on budget at 100.8% (\$86,398 vs \$85,700).

#### b. Total Income

- i) For the month, on budget at 99.8% (\$12,972 vs \$12,994).
- ii) **Year-to-date,** well above budget at 115.1% (\$124,695 vs \$108,360).

#### c. Expenses

- i) For the month, just under budget at 98.5% (\$14,919 vs \$15,150).
- ii) **Year-to-date,** under budget at 95.9% (\$117,879 vs \$122,976).

#### d. Net Operating Income (Total Income minus Expenses)

- i) For the month, slightly better than expected with a loss of \$1,947 vs. the expected loss of \$2,155.
- ii) **Year-to-date,** much better than expected with a profit of \$6,816, vs. the expected loss of \$14,616.

#### e. **Checking balance**

- i) Balance at Month-end is \$22,813.
- ii) Previous Month-end balance was \$24,768.

#### f. Comments

- i) After 2 months of above-budget Member giving, we fell short of budget for August. Hopefully we'll regroup for September. The good news is that our YTD member giving is on budget at 100.8%.
- ii) YTD Total Income and YTD Net Operating Income continue well above budget due to \$15,000 in Special Offerings from deceased members earlier this year.




# Spotlight on Ministry: Stewardship Emphasis 2021 Let your light shine – to the glory of God!


