

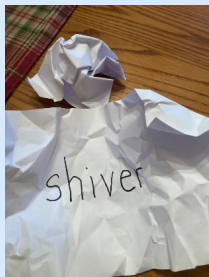

Is your child's word collection getting out of control? Or are you feeling like the word collection is nonexistent this winter? Looking for a word activity for these cold indoor days?

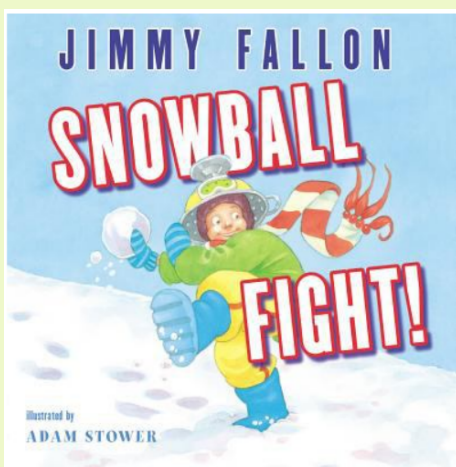
Here at JOYcabulary we understand and have a no cost activity that will sure brighten everyone's darkest days. Have a snowball fight!
