RESEARCH PROJECT “MOTIVATION AND APPLICATION IN HOMELESS RECOVERY”



2023

The "Motivation and Application in Homeless Recovery" research focused on identifying key factors/components that influence motivation application and techniques related to homeless recovery.



Successful outcomes included eight (8) of twelve (12) participants (67%), who achieved their self-identified goals for homeless recovery. Inspire Real Change research has determined that the lack of motivation and action to achieve self-identified goals was a main factor contributing to unsuccessful outcomes. Additionally, participants with successful outcomes identified the client-centered case navigation and personal goal development as positive contributing factors.

2023 Research Project InspireRealChange

"Motivation and Application in Homeless Recovery"

67%

Four of twelve participants (33%) did not achieve all or the largest percentage of their self-identified goals within the homeless recovery

Eight of twelve participants (67%) achieved their self-identified goals within the homeless recovery

"Participant goals ranged from reuniting with a family member to obtaining medical treatment for an impairment."

"The shifting goal factor is described when a participant identifies goals during their initial assessment, but changes one or more of their goals during the case navigation process."

"A client-centered strategy was utilized to identify and build on the clients' strengths and goals rather than on their challenges."

Six of twelve participants (50%) self-identified high motivation levels related to personal goals. **50%**

Participants consisted of ten males and two females. **83%**

All participants were chronically homeless, with histories reflected literal homelessness for more than one year. **100%**

"Four of twelve participants (33%) did not achieve all or the largest percentage of their goals self-identified a level of active addiction during engagement."

"Participants with successful outcomes identified the client-centered case navigation and personal goal development as positive contributing factors."
