Peonies



Peonies are perennials that will rebloom each year. With their lush foliage and beautiful blooms, you can enjoy flowers from spring to summer. Peonies are easy to grow, hardy, and perfect for cutting. They are also beautiful to line walkways or look lovely as a low hedge. Once the blooms die off, the green leaves will last all summer. Peonies love the sun and do best with 6 to 8 hours of sunlight.

Itoh Peonies (page 18-20)

Itoh peonies are a cross between Lactiflora (general peony) and Suffruticosa (tree peony). These plants develop below the soil as normal peonies (easy to divide) and above the soil as tree peonies. This results in the ultimate garden peony, one with a high decorative value. After several years, it is not unusual for the plant to produce fifty or more flowers! After flowering, the Itoh peony is still a beautiful garden plant.

Patio Peonies (page 21)

They are specially selected because of their compact growth habit and ease of flowering in pots and gardens! Peonies are also a great addition to any perennial program. Bare root plants are potted in the fall in 1-1/2 to 2 gallon pots. Plant with the eyes 1-1/2 to 2" below the surface in a well-drained perennial potting mix. Water thoroughly. For the winter, place the pots in a cool area out of direct sunlight that might warm the pots on sunny days. Plants should stay dormant until spring. Plants may be forced a few weeks earlier by placing them in a tunnel or greenhouse to encourage earlier growth. 3/5 eye divisions will produce a larger plant that will fill out the pot better and be ready to sell the following spring. Plants grown for two seasons can be expected to bring a higher price because the plants will be larger and have more flowers.

Tree Peonies (page 22-23)



Tree peonies are woody shrubs native to China. These Peonies are much different from their cousins, the herbaceous "regular" peonies. Tree peonies do not die to the ground but rather grow off the old wood each year. When mature, they can be up to 6 ft in width and height. Most varieties are hardy in Zones 4-8. They like moist soil and grow best in full sun or a small amount of shade. They are deer and disease resistant. At full maturity, they can have up to 50 huge flower heads. Grown in the Netherlands, they are 2-year-old roots.

Peony Growing Information

Cut Flower Peonies

Peonies grow best when planted in loamy soil with good drainage in full sun. Peonies will grow in Zones 3 - 8. In warmer areas, select a north-facing slope so the soil isn't warmed on sunny winter days. Peonies need at least 40 days of near freezing temperatures or colder to produce quality flowers. The longer and colder the winter dormant period, the better. Select your planting area carefully. If planted and cared for properly, the peonies you plant this year will still be going strong fifty years from now.

Long term weed management is important for optimum cut flower production. Planting in landscape fabric makes long term weed management easier. Use a sharp knife or scissors to cut an X into the fabric large enough to plant through. The flaps of the X will cover the hole and the peonies will grow through it. The holes will need to be enlarged each year as the plants get larger. Be sure the fabric is well anchored with rocks or sand bags to prevent it from blowing away during high winds. Prepare the planting area before installing the fabric by adding compost, shredded leaves or other soil building matter. Plant bare roots with the eyes 1-1/2 to 2" below the surface. Planting deeper than 2" may reduce the number of flowers produced. Firm the soil around the roots and water thoroughly after planting.

Provide adequate, deep watering during the first season as the plants get established. Flower buds for the next season develop in late summer. Be sure to water during dry summers. Remove the dead foliage in the fall to help prevent overwintering of any disease.

Flowers should be picked at the marshmallow (soft when slightly pinched) stage before they open. Blooms that would be expected to open in a day or two are ready to be picked. Remove most of the leaves as they are picked. If flowers are stored dry, they do not need to go into water as they are picked in the field. They can then be placed loosely (ideally) in crates in the cooler to provide maximum circulation. Make sure there is no moisture on the flowers or stems when they go into the cooler or you'll find moldy flowers when you take them out later. When the flowers are needed, take them out of the cooler about a day before they are needed. Cut the stems, removing the dried up lower portion of the stems and place in a warmer area out of sunlight. They will rehydrate in a couple of hours and be ready to use. Flowers that will not be stored dry should be harvested into water and then stored in the cooler up to seven days. Growing peonies in a tunnel will cause them to bloom two to three weeks earlier than plants grown in the open field. The tunnel should be left open all winter and then closed up about four weeks before peonies in the field start to grow. Extending the harvest period will increase the number of peonies you can sell.



These are specially selected because of their compact growth habit and ease of flowering in pots and gardens! Peonies are also a great addition to any perennial program. Bare root plants are potted in the fall in 1-1/2 to 2 gallon pots. Plant with the eyes 1-1/2 to 2" below the surface in a well-drained perennial potting mix. Water thoroughly. For the winter, place the pots in a cool area out of direct sunlight that might warm the pots on sunny days.

Tree Peonies

Tree peonies are woody shrubs native to China. These Peonies are much different from their cousins, the herbaceous "regular" peonies. Tree peonies do not die to the ground but rather grow off the old wood each year. When mature, they can be up to 6 ft in width and height. Most varieties are hardy in Zones 4-8. They like moist soil and grow best in full sun or a small amount of shade. They are deer and disease resistant. At full maturity, they can have up to 50 huge flower heads. Grown in the Netherlands, they are 2-year-old roots.

Tree Peony Growing Information

All Tree Peonies commercially sold are grafted plants, grafted onto Peony Lactiflora whose roots usually develop horizontally and shallow. It is important to make sure plants develop vigorous new roots during the first couple of growing seasons. This can be done by adding additional mulch on the surface of the soil and covering them with a burlap bag to protect them against the cold dry wind in winter.

Under the right conditions, Tree Peonies can survive for many years (the oldest one in Japan is over 200 years old!). They are hardy in Zones 4~8. Tree Peonies grow well in both full sun and/or partial shade. Tree Peonie prefers fertile, moist, but well-drained soil.

We recommend feeding with a slow release of organic fertilizer twice a year. First fertilization (3-6-5) should be done after flowering and second fertilization (5-10-8) should be in November or December.




LANDSCAPING


Peonies in the landscape need a sunny location with good soil, and good drainage. Plant the eyes 1-1/2 to 2" below the surface, and water well after planting. Remember to provide adequate watering during the first season and in future years during drought periods. Plants can be mulched with compost or shredded mulch, keeping the mulch away from the emerging stems in the spring. If Peony flowers are too heavy for the stems to support, use peony rings for added support. Deadhead flowers after they fade to prevent seeds from forming. Peonies can stay in the same spot for many years without the need to divide or thin them. Choose your planting location carefully. Remove the dead foliage in the fall to help prevent overwintering of any disease.


