#### **New Business**

- Introductions & Welcome
  - No new members were present. All in attendance already knew of each other.
- Review Scouting Heritage (Together)
  - Together we read pages 7-9 from the "Scouting Heritage" merit badge manual. This will continue to be a part of each meeting going forward until the committee is completed with the book. This is to provide a historical context of the Boy Scouts of America to those who have little to no experience with the BSA on the Council and to remind those who do. (Mike I have a copy for you).
- Overview of roles and responsibilities as members of this committee
  - A broad overview was provided that the roles in which the committee plays is similar to a Board of Directors who
    will help to make decisions to help support the Cub Scout and Troop and keep a working relationship between

Tom Ochs and I will work with Mike and Jim to formulate the proposed budgets for the Committee's review along with a proposed schedule of activities by month for the same time frame.
