GOMA Board Meeting Minutes

6:00 pm Tues Nov. 10, 2020 Via ZOOM Conference

- 1. Board meeting called to order at 6:02
- 2. Roll Call (Board members): Matt, Pam, Cathy, Ken, Chuck, and Michelle
- 3. Previous meeting minutes: Acknowledge July 21st. Meeting minutes which board approved via email & was posted.
- 4. Board member Election results: Pam announced board election results
 - 33 ballots turned in
 - Chuck, Matt, and Michelle have been elected for another 2 years
 - Next election will be up November 2021
 - A concern was brought up about automatic payments and residents not voting
 - a. Michelle will investigate survey options to send, via email, to residents to collect votes.
- 5. Treasurer's report:
 - Pam reported income & expenses based on October '20 reporting.
 - a. Interest made on our CD's.
 - b. HOA dues are down this month un-sure why. Budgeted that we would collect \$55,000 and we are only up to \$45,000. Board discussed the current process to collect dues and ideas moving forward.
 - 1. Decision: 90 days late, residents will get a notice. After 30 days, a fee is always charged. This is noted on the residents HOA statement.
 - c. GOMA Insurance: Matt suggested we drop our Umbrella policy and increase our General Liability, saving us \$375/year. Chuck motioned to remove umbrella policy and add an additional 1M to the General Liability Insurance, Cathy seconded the motion.
- 6. CCR Non-compliance Process & Fees Discussion
 - Board will be researching options of time limits in the neighborhood (ex; trailers, motorhomes, boats, etc.) and when homeowners would receive a letter as well as fines. Matt and Pam will come up with a fine schedule and send to Board from approval.
- 7. Landscape Report and Sprinkler System Update:
 - Matt reported that the sprinkler review is complete in the entire neighborhood (count=2,500 sprinklers). Haskell has the most tree root problem and will be addressed in the spring. Review was done through volunteer efforts. Their efforts saved GOMA over \$2,000 dollars.
 - Chuck reported that a family in N Haskell is requesting a large stump and a tree be removed. Both are under GOMA maintenance agreement. Cost would not exceed \$350 from HOA. Contractor to come in on Nov. 25th. Chuck suggested Board to consider having tree removed. Michelle motioned to remove the tree and stump and Ken seconded.
- 8. Communications & Newsletter:
 - Cathy asked for suggested for upcoming newsletter. (Fine Schedule for Trailers/Boats & Letter from the President were suggested.)
 - All submissions to Cathy on December 11th

- Michelle will have newsletter printed the week of Christmas and to Granger by Dec. 28 date for Jan newsletter mail-out

 - Ken reported that requests have slowed down. Last request they received was outside paint request and this was approved.
